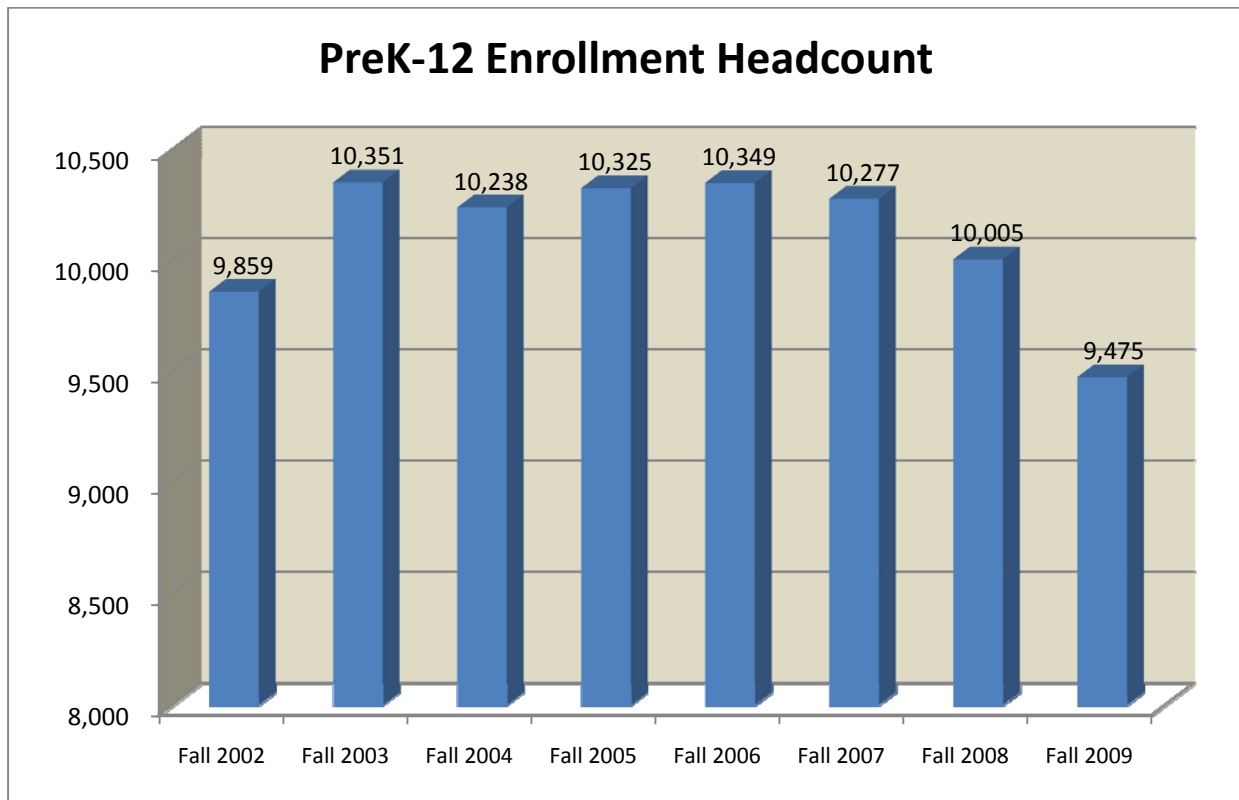


PreK-12 EDUCATION

PreK-12 Current Year Enrollment

Total PreK-12 enrollments decreased 530 students (5.3%) from 10,005 in fall 2008 to 9,475 in fall 2009. In 2009, 36 schools reported compared to 35 schools in 2008.

PreK-12 Enrollment Trends



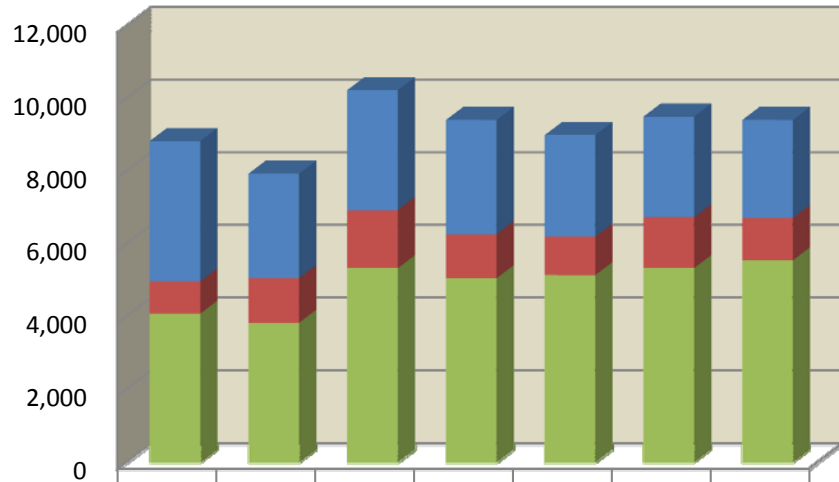
Seven-year PreK-12 Education Enrollment Trends by Institution, Based on Headcount

Twelve schools had enrollment increases over the past seven years, 21 schools had decreases and one had no change. Seven-year trend reporting gives a more accurate enrollment trend, but the one-year picture is included which reflects the most recent changes. (Note: Several schools have not participated in MEA enrollment reporting long enough to show a seven-year change but they are included with the number of years change indicated in parentheses.) Two new schools, Christian Life Academy (Hopedale, Ill.) and The Peace and Justice Academy (Pasadena, Calif.), joined MSC in 2009.

Racial/Ethnic Enrollment Changes, Fall 2004 through Fall 2009, PreK-12 Schools

Racial/Ethnic enrollment information for MSC schools was calculated from enrollment information reported as part of an annual data instrument report to the council. Racial/Ethnic enrollment counts include all students from under-represented Racial/Ethnic groups, not just Mennonite Church USA. Only schools reporting this information are included in this table. The changes in the Racial/Ethnic student percentage of enrollment reflect the variations in the schools that reported from year to year.

A new enrollment reporting form introduced in 2008 resulted in an increase in the number of schools reporting (from 16 schools in fall 2007 to 35 in fall 2009). This explains part of the significant growth in total number of Racial/Ethnic students from 572 in fall 2007 to 1,847 in fall 2009.
