Bluffton University also has 126 students (99 FTE) in its adult degree-completion program. In addition, Bluffton has 122 students (105 full-time, 17 part-time, 113 FTE) in graduate programs. (A "full-time" student on the graduate level takes a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester; for calculating "full-time-equivalent," the normal progress toward graduation is 6 credit hours).

Eastern Mennonite University also has 175 students (149 full-time, 26 part-time, 155 FTE) in its adult degree-completion program. In addition, EMU has 326 students (74 full-time, 252 part-time, 148 FTE) in graduate programs apart from the seminary. (A "full-time student" on the graduate level takes a minimum of 9 credit hours per semester; for calculating "full-time-equivalent," the normal progress toward graduation is 12 credit hours).

Goshen College also has 54 students (47 full-time, 7 part-time, 52 FTE) in its adult degree-completion program. In addition, Goshen has 43 students (8 full-time, 35 part-time, 36 FTE) in graduate programs. (A "full-time student" on the graduate level takes a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester; for calculating "full-time equivalent," the normal progress toward graduation is 15 credit hours).

**Definitions of full-time equivalent:

Method A: Total student-hours or student-courses in the fall term divided by the normal progress toward graduation per term. For example, for the traditional 120 semester hours to be earned in eight semesters, the total student-semester-hours would be divided by 15.

Method B: The full-time-equivalent of part-time students (calculated as in Method A) added to the total number of full-time students.
