# OVERVIEW OF ENROLLMENT REPORTS

Enrollment numbers are one of many ways to look at our Mennonite educational institutions and programs. It is the intent of this report to offer a glimpse into Mennonite education by focusing on one area: enrollment. For those who are interested in more in-depth analysis or more information on a specific area, please contact the MEA office at [info@mennoniteeducation.org](mailto:info@mennoniteeducation.org).

MEA has gathered enrollment statistics from the various education levels and educational programs for many years. Enrollment statistics at the PreK-12 level include only the member schools of Mennonite Schools Council (MSC). Please note that two international schools are affiliated members of MSC—Colegio Americas Unidas in Colombia and Lezha Academic Center in Albania. Other Mennonite PreK-12 schools and early childhood education centers scattered across North America that are not MSC members are not included in these reports. Preschool enrollment data was also collected from Mennonite Early Childhood Network members.

The enrollment data is presented using the following levels and/or categories:

**Preschool programs** of Mennonite Early Childhood Network (MECN)

**Prekindergarten, elementary, middle, and secondary programs** of Mennonite Schools Council (MSC) schools

**Undergraduate programs** of Bethel College, Bluffton University, Eastern Mennonite University (EMU), Goshen College and Hesston College

**Adult degree-completion programs** of Bluffton University, EMU and Goshen College

**Graduate programs** of Bluffton University, EMU and Goshen College

**Seminary programs** of Anabaptist Mennonite Biblical Seminary (AMBS) and Eastern Mennonite Seminary (EMS)

**Other degree program** of Seminario Bíblico Anabautista Hispano (SeBAH)

**Non-degree program** of Instituto Bíblico Anabautista (IBA)

Under each level are current year statistics and basic enrollment trend charts or tables. We have chosen to further break down the enrollment data by focusing on Mennonite enrollment data (both Mennonite Church USA and other Mennonite groups) and Racial/Ethnic enrollment data (including both U.S. Racial/Ethnic and international students).

As you look at the numbers and reach your own conclusions, here are some helpful definitions:

**Full-time** – students taking the number of credit hours required by the institution to receive full-time status

**Part-time** – students taking fewer credit hours than the minimum needed for full-time status

**FTE** – full-time equivalent (adding the credit hours of both full-time and part-time students to determine the possible number of full-time students)

**Head count** – total number of students regardless of their part-time or full-time status

**BIPOC** –students from under-represented Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC) groups from the United States

**International** - students at U.S. schools from countries other than the United States, and students at Canadian schools from countries other than Canada

The interpretation of the numbers can be viewed from several perspectives—usually shaped by the question or the person reading the data. For the purpose of this report, the focus was determined by the MEA outcome statement focused on “ready and viable access” as stated below:

***Viable Access.*** Students seeking Christ-centered Anabaptist-Mennonite education have viable access to Mennonite Church USA schools.

Working with the schools on issues related to location, delivery system, cost, transfer and outreach to the under-served, MEA envisions and supports programs and initiatives that facilitate ready accessibility.

# REPORT SUMMARY

## Current Year Systemwide Enrollment

Mennonite educational institutions are touching the lives of 8,971 students (based on headcount) in fall 2023, a decrease of 319 (3.4%) students from the 2022 total of 9,290. In higher education, the total headcount decreased by 67 students (with decreases of 12 in graduate, 100 in undergraduate, and increases of 43 in adult degree-completion and 2 in seminary). Preschool, elementary, and secondary education levels showed a decrease of 359 (6.7%). All higher education institutions reported their enrollment numbers. For the academic year 2023-2024, there are 24 MSC schools (22-member schools and two affiliates), and MEA received data from 18 of them. For the previous academic year, data was received from 18 MSC schools.

Headcount information from Mennonite Early Childhood Network (MECN) preschool/childcare centers (non-MSC schools) is included. For the academic year 2023-2024 MEA received data from four preschool/childcare centers that was not part of an MSC school. The data varies from year to year depending on which preschool centers report information.

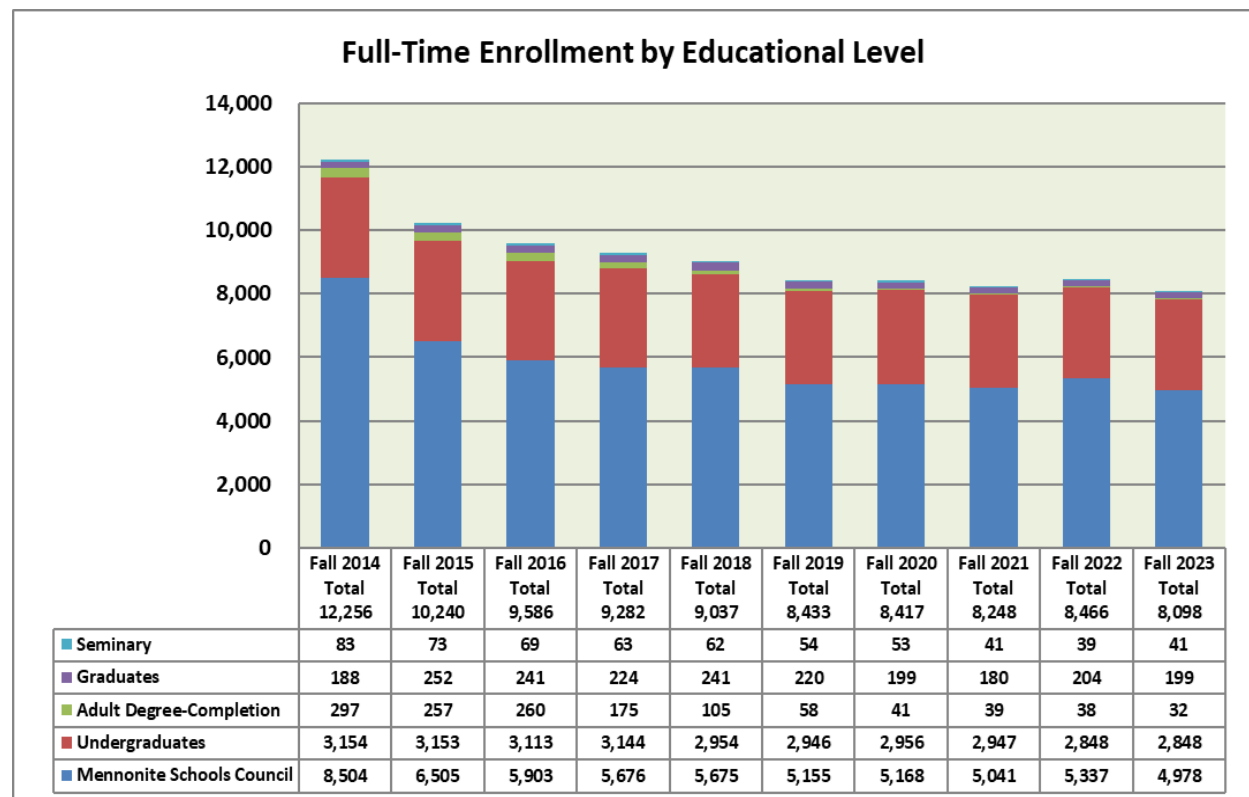
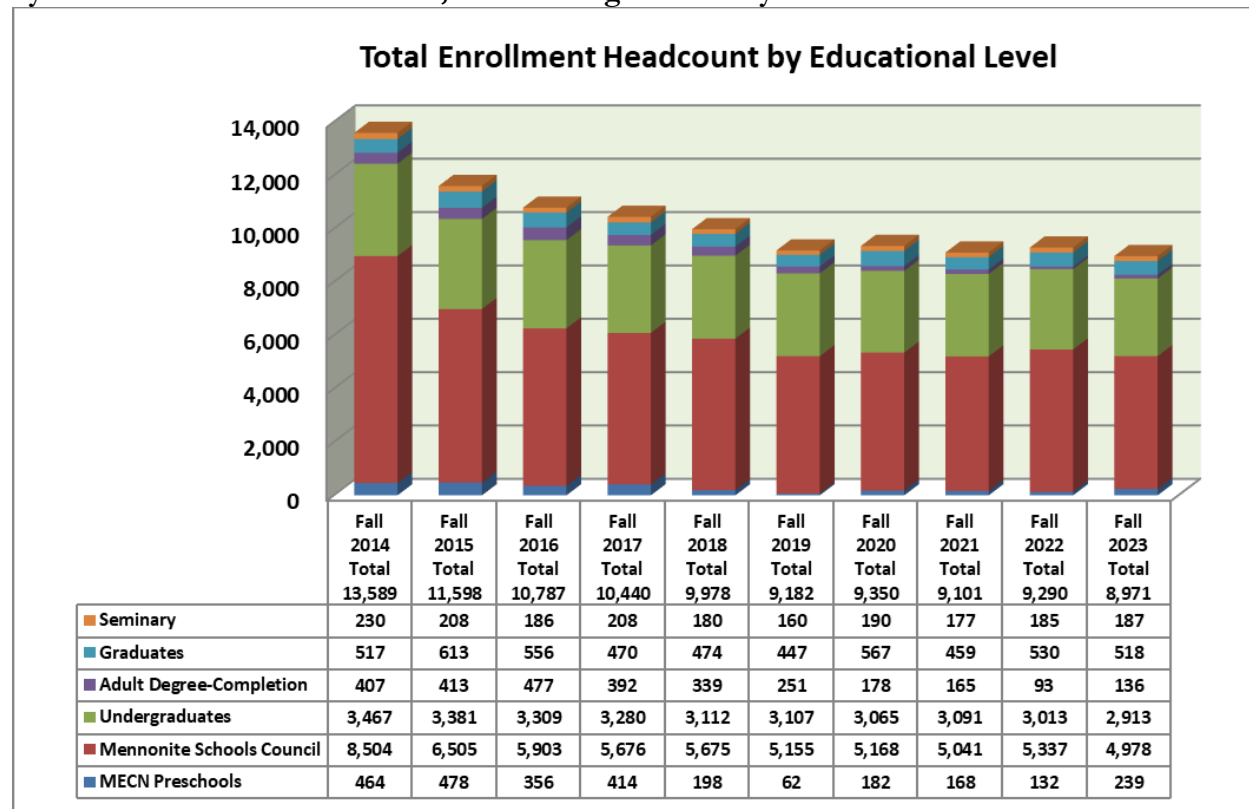
## Current Year Systemwide Mennonite Enrollment

“Mennonite Church USA” students include only those that report attending a Mennonite Church USA congregation. All other Mennonites are included in the “All Mennonite” category. Note that the number of Mennonite Church USA students in higher education in fall 2023 (359) decreased from the 2022 total (402) for a combined decrease of 43 while PreK-12 decreased 160 for a total net decrease of 203 in fall 2023.

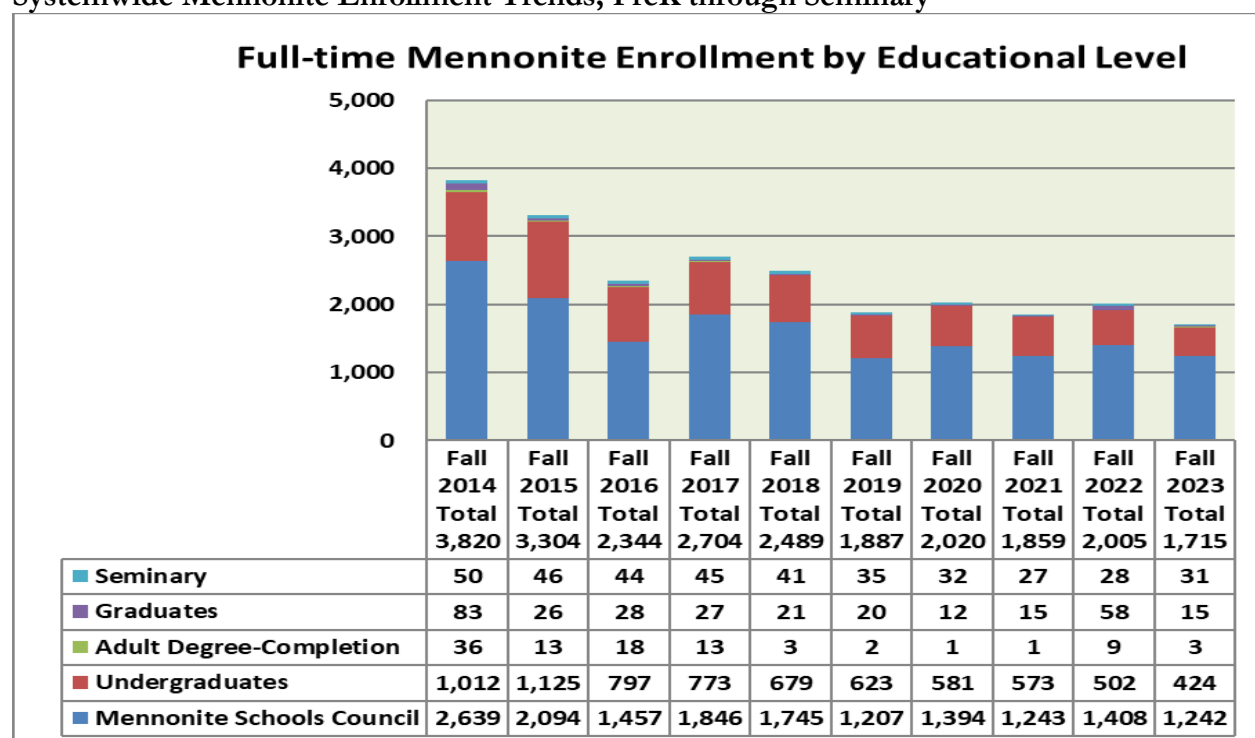

### Multi-year Mennonite Full-time Students as Percentage of Total Enrollment, 2018-2023

In 2023, Mennonite Church USA students comprise 14.0% of the total full-time enrollment at all levels, and full-time all Mennonites account for 21.4% of the total full-time enrollment. The systemwide full-time Mennonite Church USA and other Mennonite student enrollment decreased 290 students (14.5%) from 2,005 in Fall 2022 to 1,715 in Fall 2023. Full-time enrollment data from Fall 2018 to 2023 are included for comparative purposes. The Mennonite student population for the total enrollment breaks out as follows:

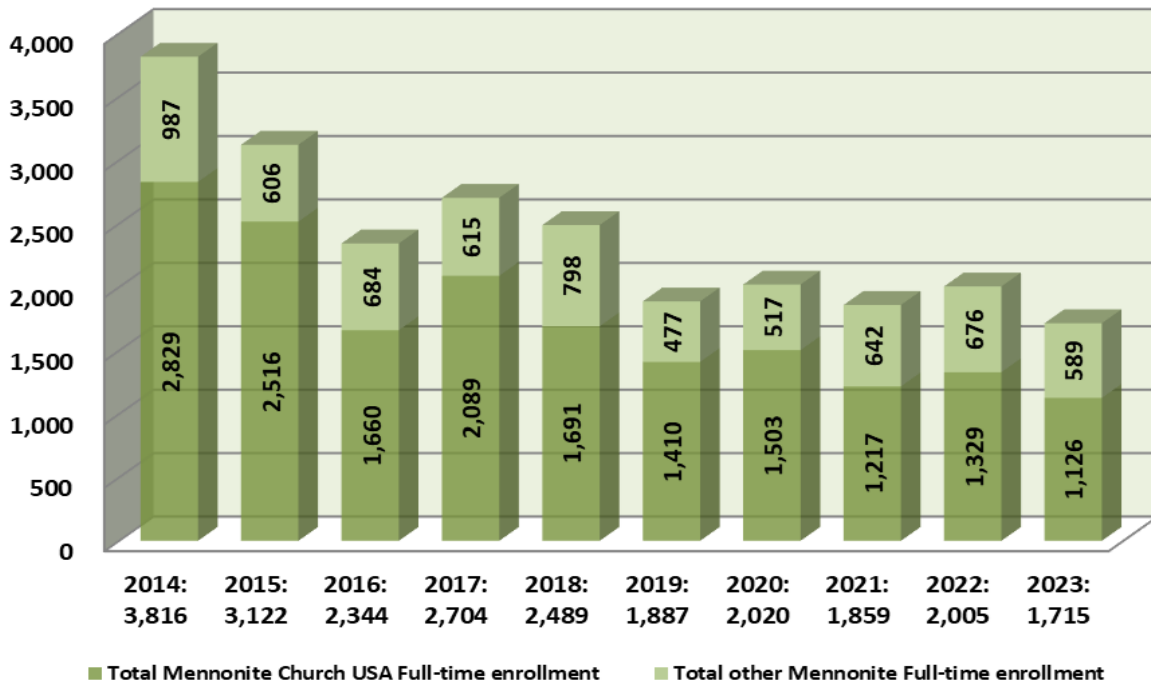

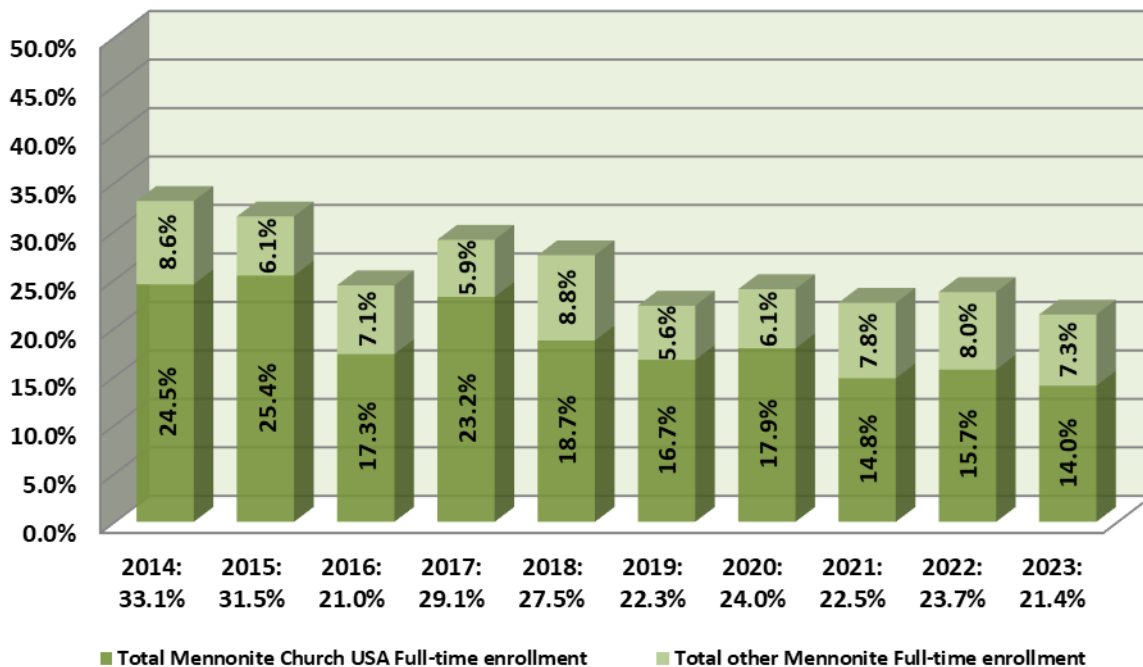
The total number of all Mennonites attending higher education institutions decreased from 744 to 473 (36.4%) from 2018 to 2023. All areas of higher education except Seminary experienced a decrease (Undergraduate from 502 to 424—15.3%, Adult degree-completion from 9 to 3—9.4%, and Graduate from 58 to 15—7.5%) during the same period. Seminary education showed an increased (Seminary from 28 to 31—75.6%). In this section, the PreK numbers from MECN institutions or programs that are not part of MSC schools are not included because the number of Mennonite/non-Mennonite students is not available.

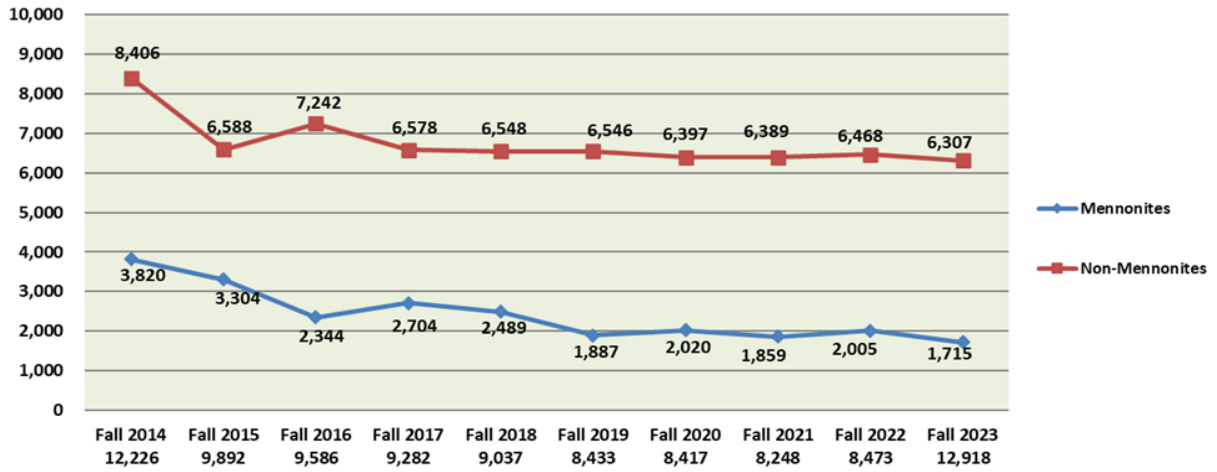


### Systemwide Full-time Mennonite Church USA and other Mennonite Students as Percentage of Total Enrollment

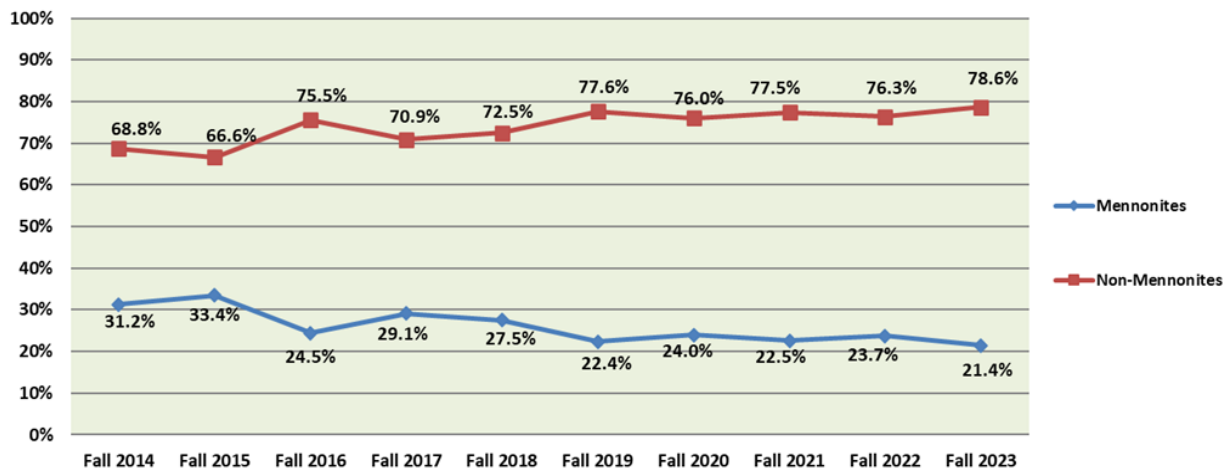




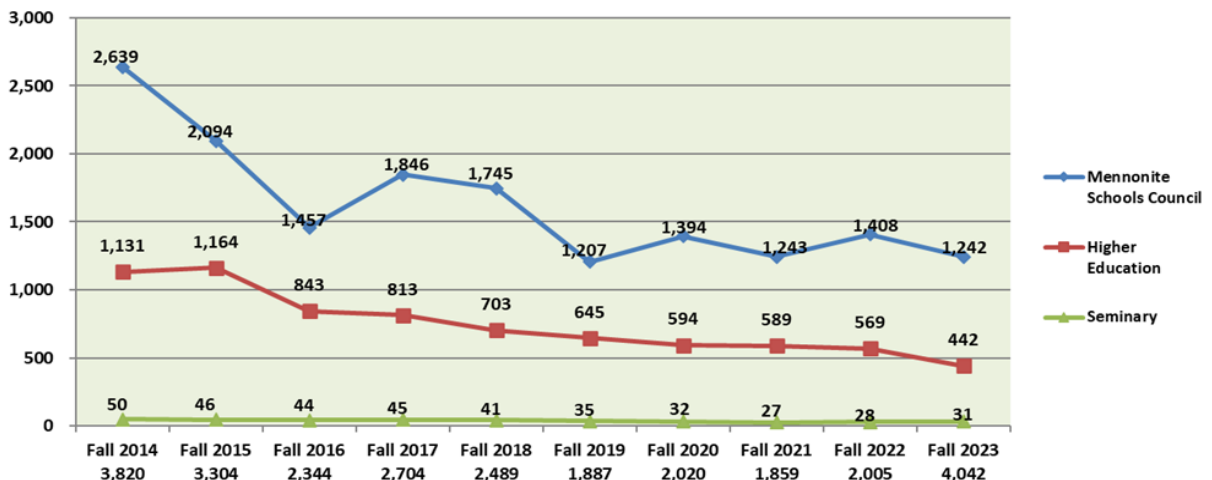
**Systemwide Total Full-time

# **PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS**

## **Mennonite Early Childhood Network**

The Mennonite Early Childhood Network (MECN) was established in 2005 to address the care and education of children, birth through kindergarten, in through-the-week programs. The mission of MECN, is to assist in developing the whole child spiritually, physically, emotionally, socially and cognitively with a framework that reflects an Anabaptist interpretation\* of the Christian faith by providing information and resources for parents and early educators of all children, birth through kindergarten. (\*Christ is the center of our faith, Community is the center of our life, Reconciliation is the center of our work)

MECN provides resources for nurturing young children, including the website *Building Faith* at <http://buildingfaithmecn.weebly.com/> written by Mennonite parents of young children to provide Anabaptist-based resources for those who raise and teach young children. The MECN website includes resources for early childhood education ([www.MennoniteEducation.org](http://www.MennoniteEducation.org)), encourages networking opportunities among its members, and represents Mennonite early childhood education at Mennonite conferences.

### **MECN Survey Results – Fall 2023**

Sixteen early childhood programs responded to the Mennonite Early Childhood data survey. Twelve of these are Mennonite Schools Council members. Four are independent centers housed in a Mennonite churches.

The programs represented were:

- preschool as part of a school program
- preschool (separate from a school program)

Seven schools reported having a state license plus regional accreditation or participation in a quality rating system like the STARS rating, accreditation by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC), or accreditation by a regional body.

Mennonite early childhood centers serve a diverse mix of families. This includes Mennonite and related Anabaptist families, families from other denominations, and families with no faith affiliation.

The early childhood centers represented in this report were started out of parent, family, community, church and school initiatives in each decade since the 1970s.

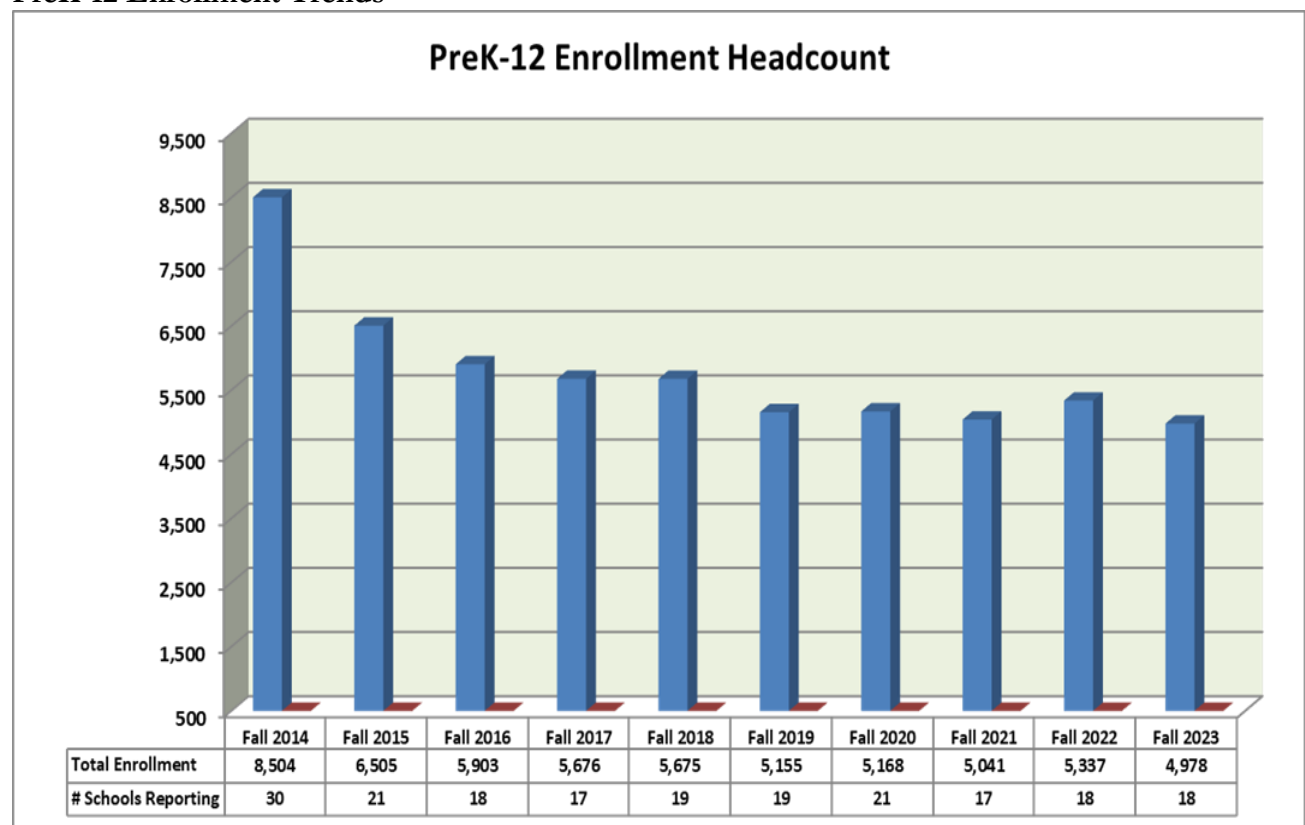

# PreK-12 EDUCATION: Mennonite Schools Council

## PreK-12 Current Year Enrollment

Total PreK-12 enrollments decreased 350 students (6.6%) from 5,337 in fall 2022 to 4,987 in fall 2023. For the academic year 2023-24, there are 24 MSC member schools (including two affiliates), and MEA received data from 18 of them. For the previous academic year, data was received from 18 MSC member schools.

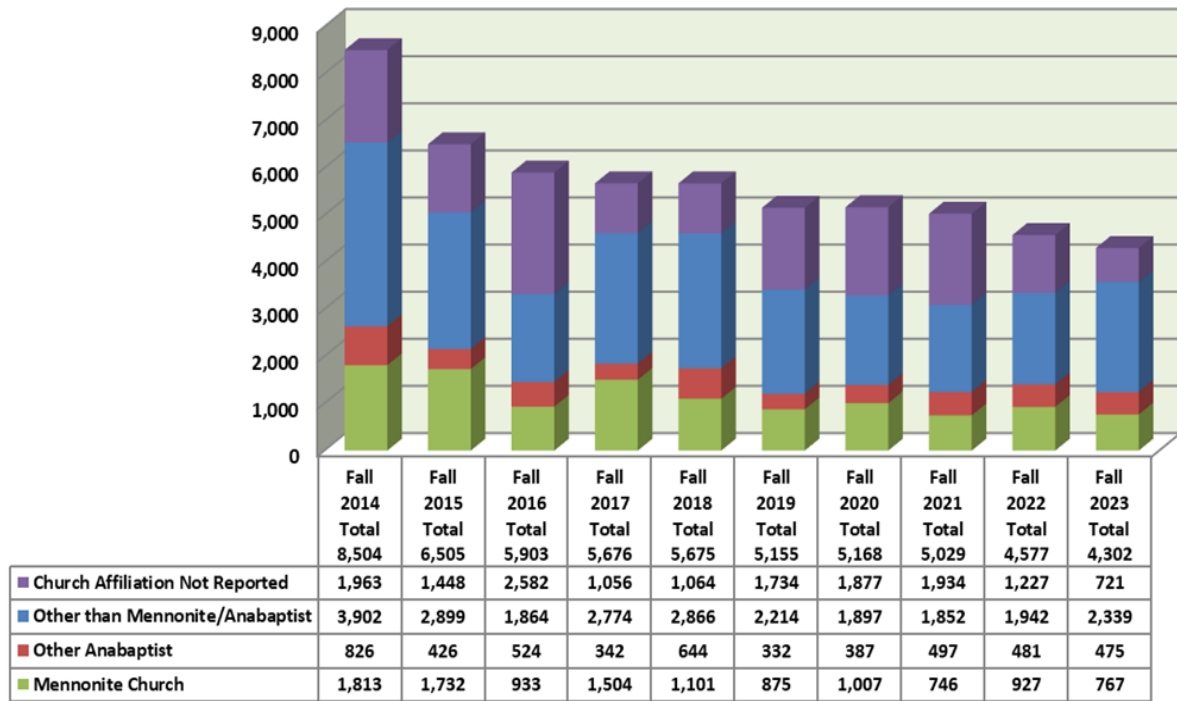


### Ten-year PreK-12 Education Enrollment Trends by Institution, Based on Headcount

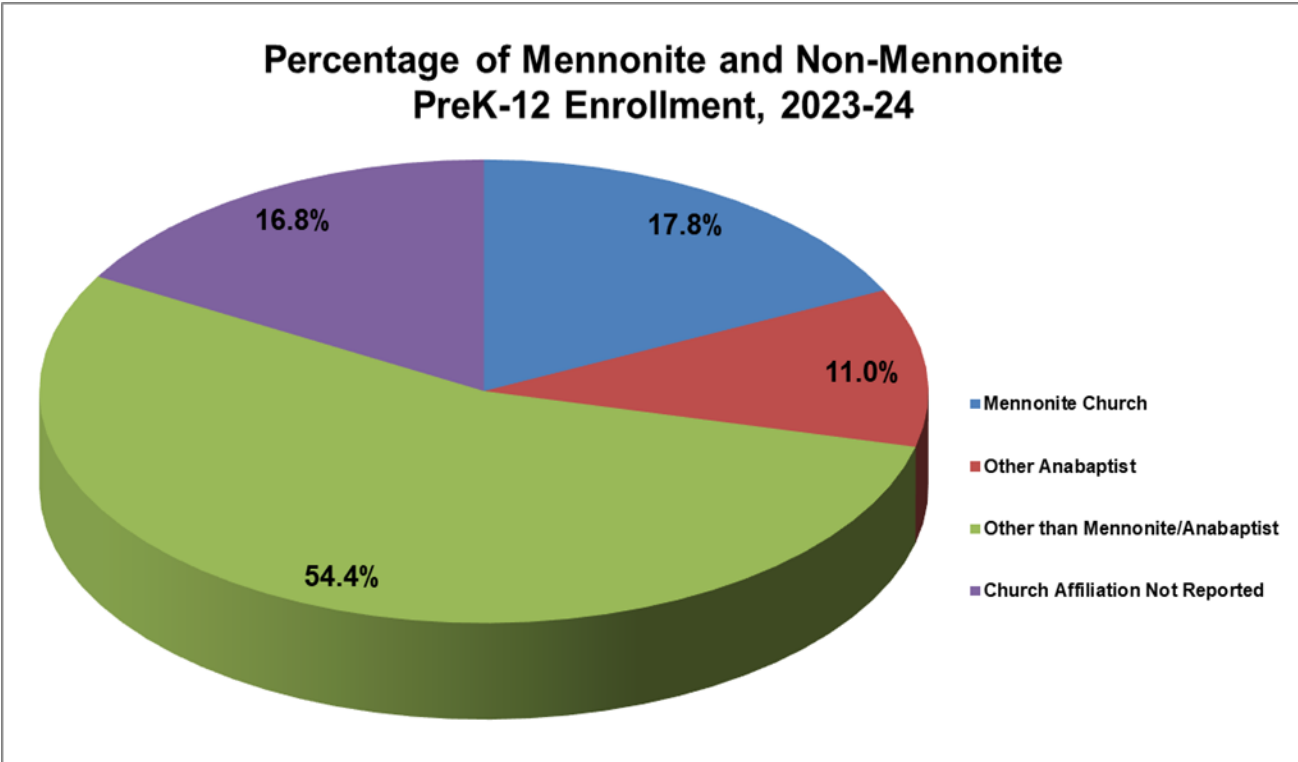
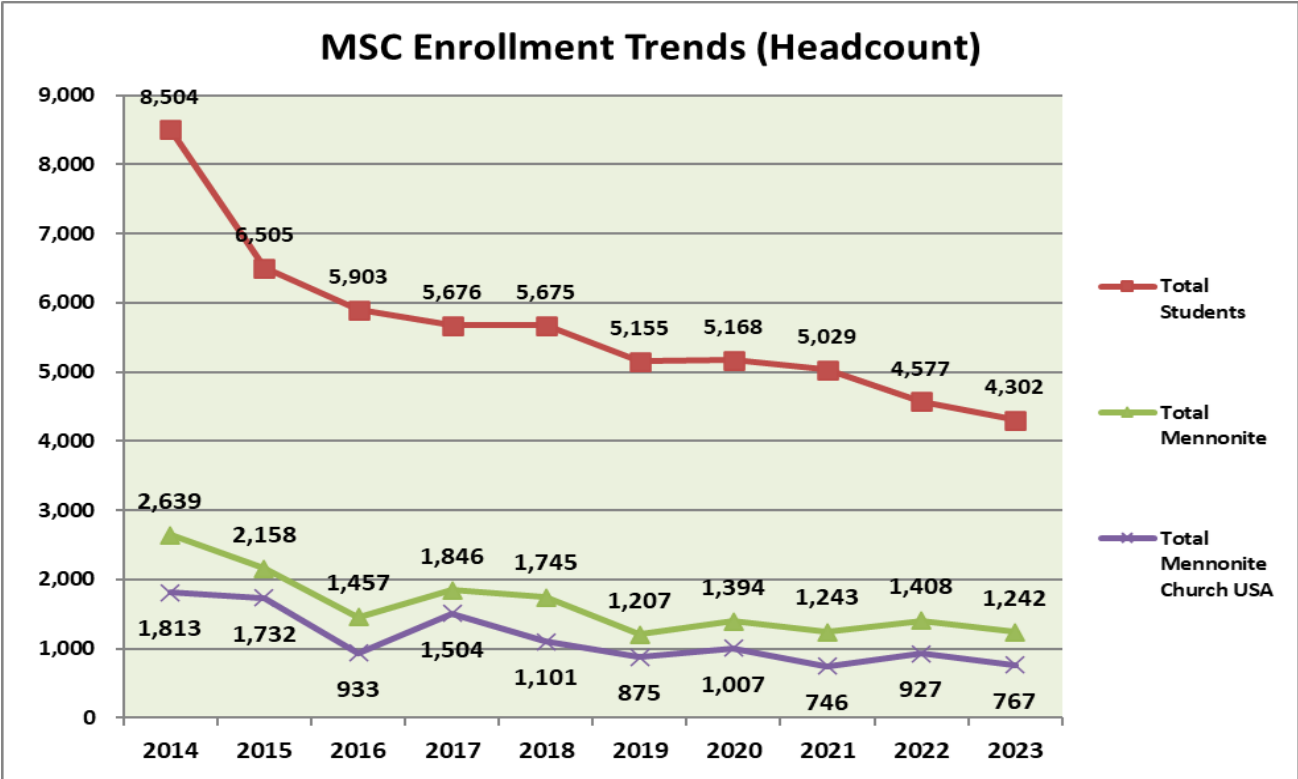

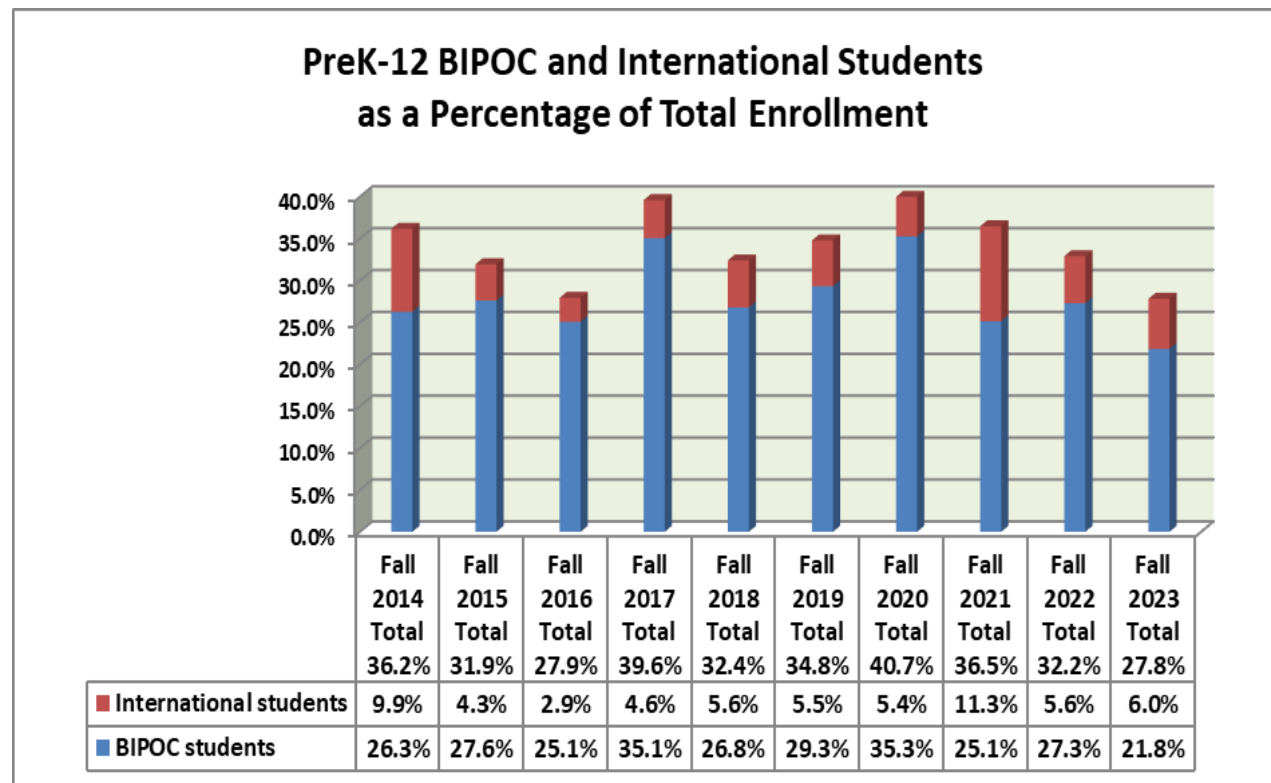
## BIPOC Enrollment Changes, Fall 2016 through Fall 2023, PreK-12 Schools

BIPOC enrollment counts include all students from under-represented BIPOC groups, not just Mennonite Church USA. Only schools reporting this information are included in this table.

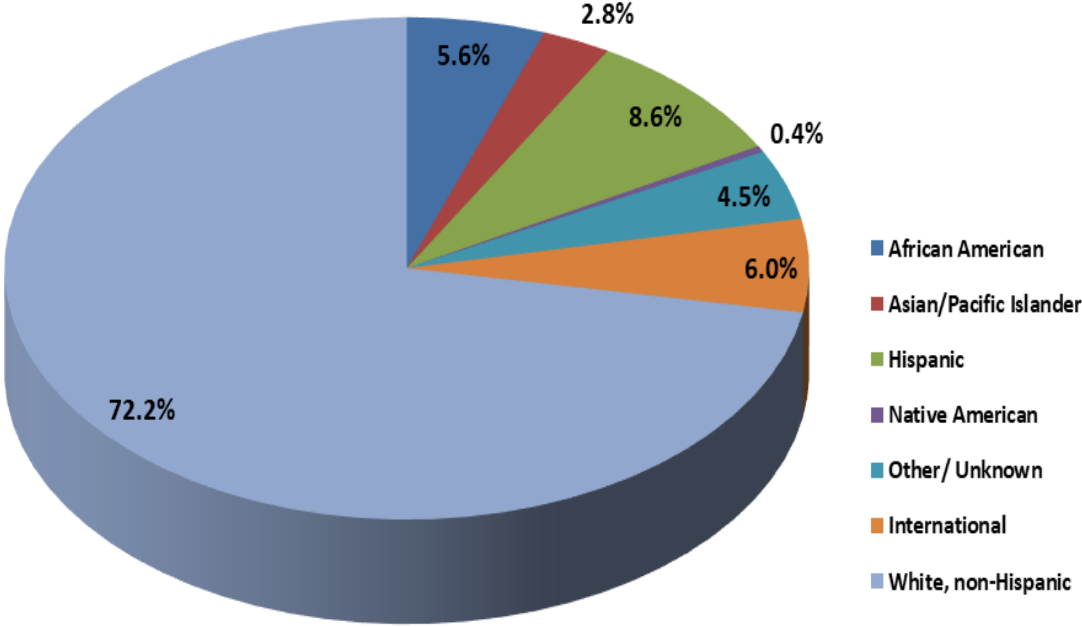
The changes in the BIPOC student percentage of enrollment reflect variations in the schools that reported from year to year.

MSC schools have experienced a decrease in the BIPOC population. Another way to look at the data would be that in fall 2016, the average number of BIPOC students in each of the 16 reporting institutions was 68, and in 2023 the average number of BIPOC students in each of the 17 reporting institutions was 58.

# HIGHER EDUCATION:

## Undergraduate Programs

### Current Year

- The undergraduate headcount decreased 107 students from 3,020 in fall 2022 to 2,913 in fall 2023, a decrease of 3.5%.
- The undergraduate full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment decreased by 91 FTE students (3.1%), from 2,908 in fall 2022 to 2,817 in fall 2023, compared with a decrease of 83 FTE students (2.8%) from 2,991 in fall 2021 to 2,908 in fall 2022.
- The undergraduate full-time enrollment decreased by 83 students, from 2,855 in fall 2022 to 2,772 in fall 2023, a decrease of 2.9%.
- The undergraduate part-time enrollment decreased by 24 students, from 165 in fall 2022 to 141 in fall 2023, a decrease of 14.5%.

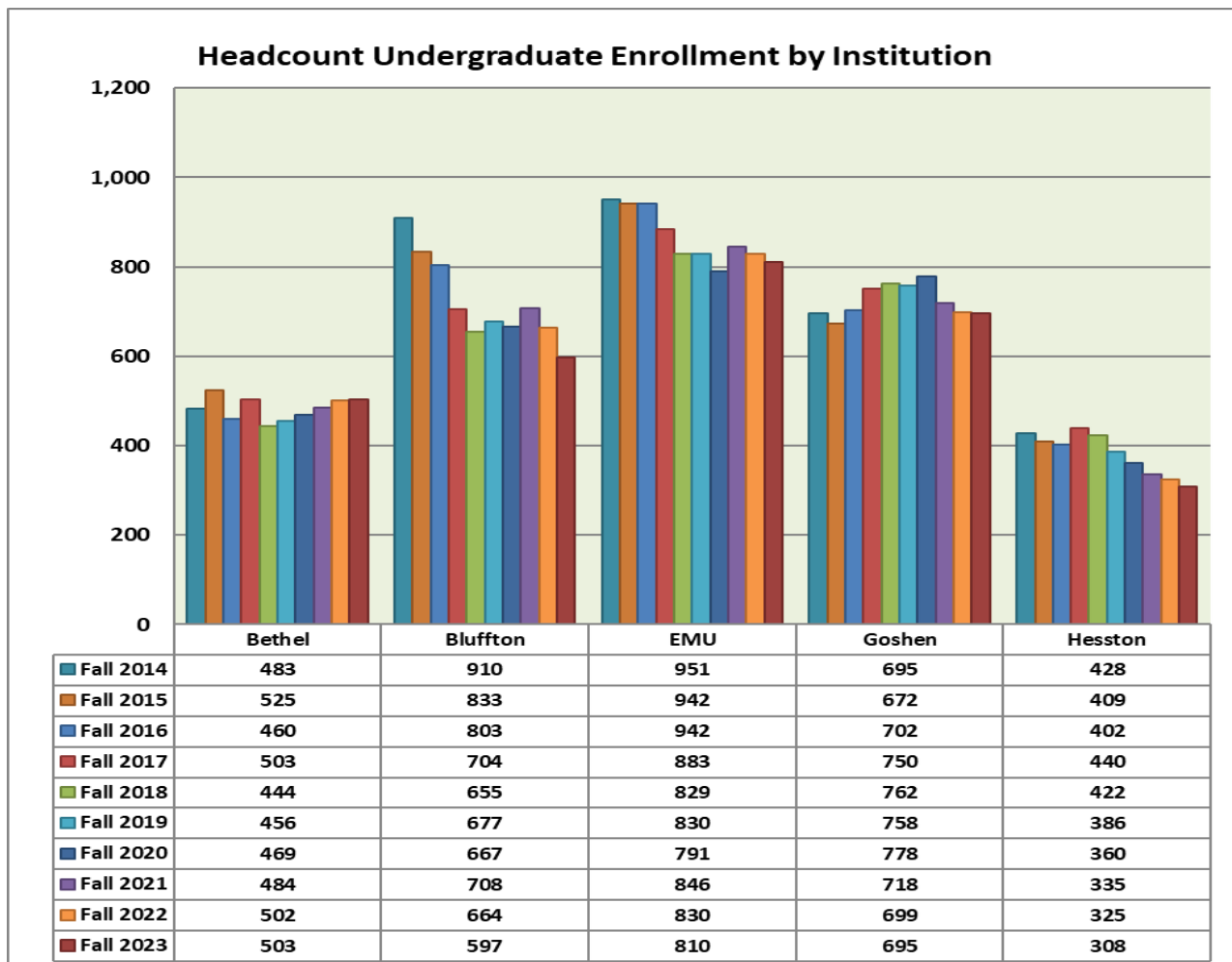
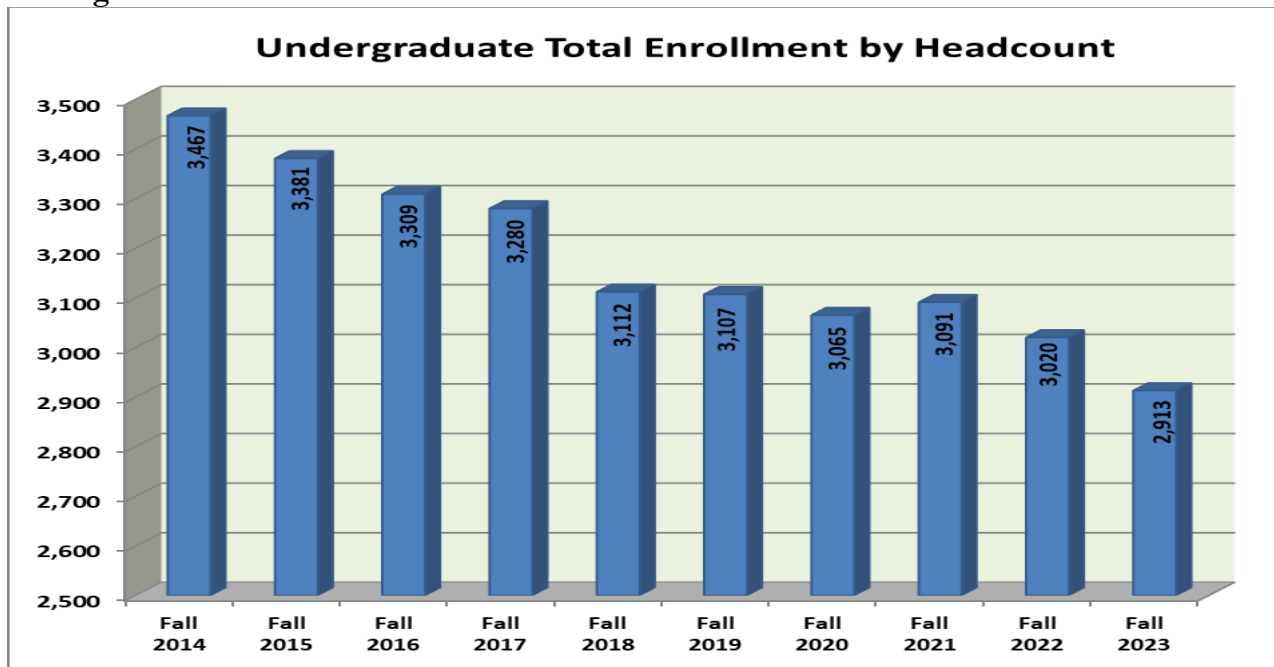
### Current Year Undergraduate Mennonite Enrollment

- The undergraduate full-time Mennonite (Mennonite Church USA and other Mennonite groups) student enrollment decreased by 78 students (15.5%) from 502 in 2022 to 424 in 2023.

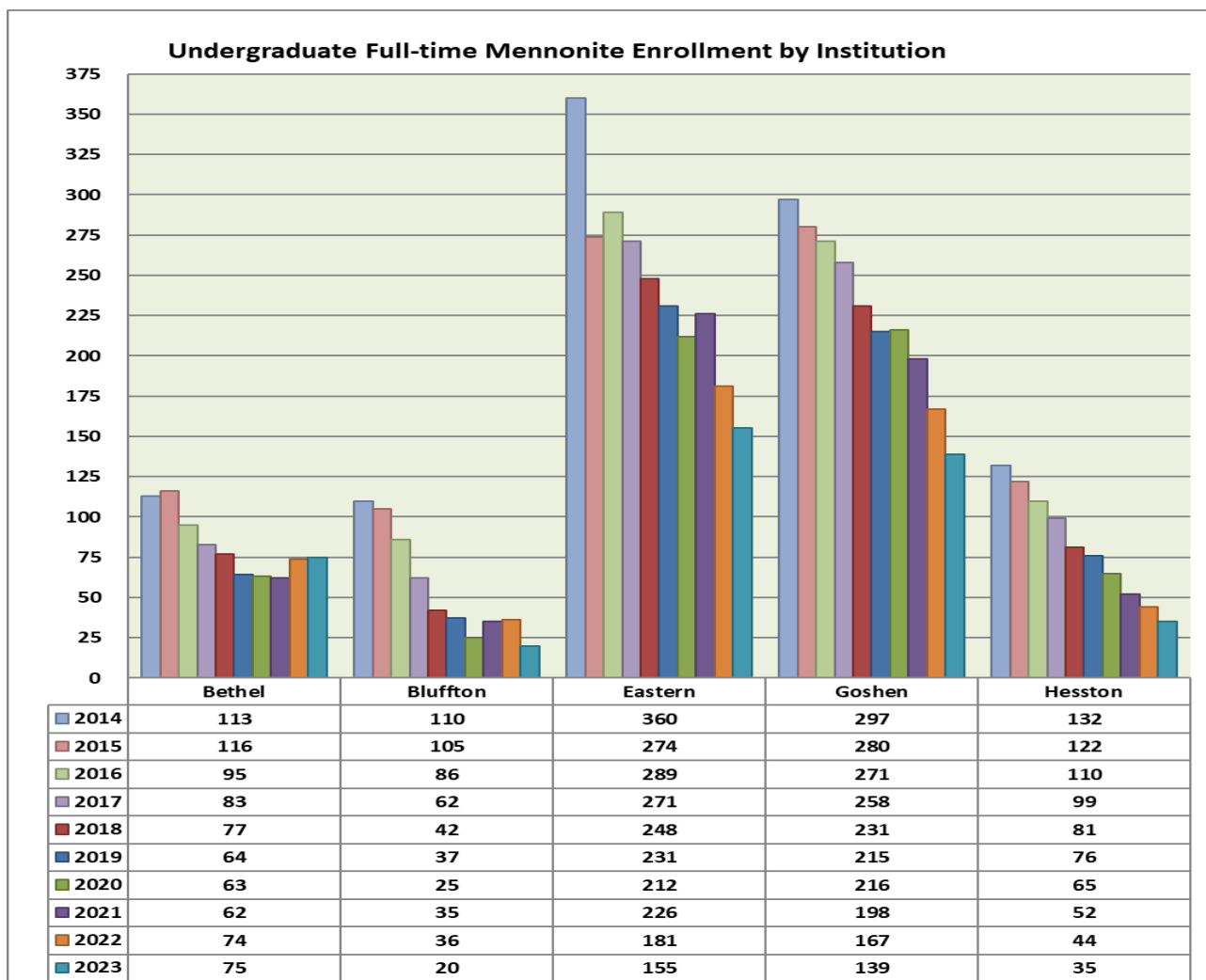
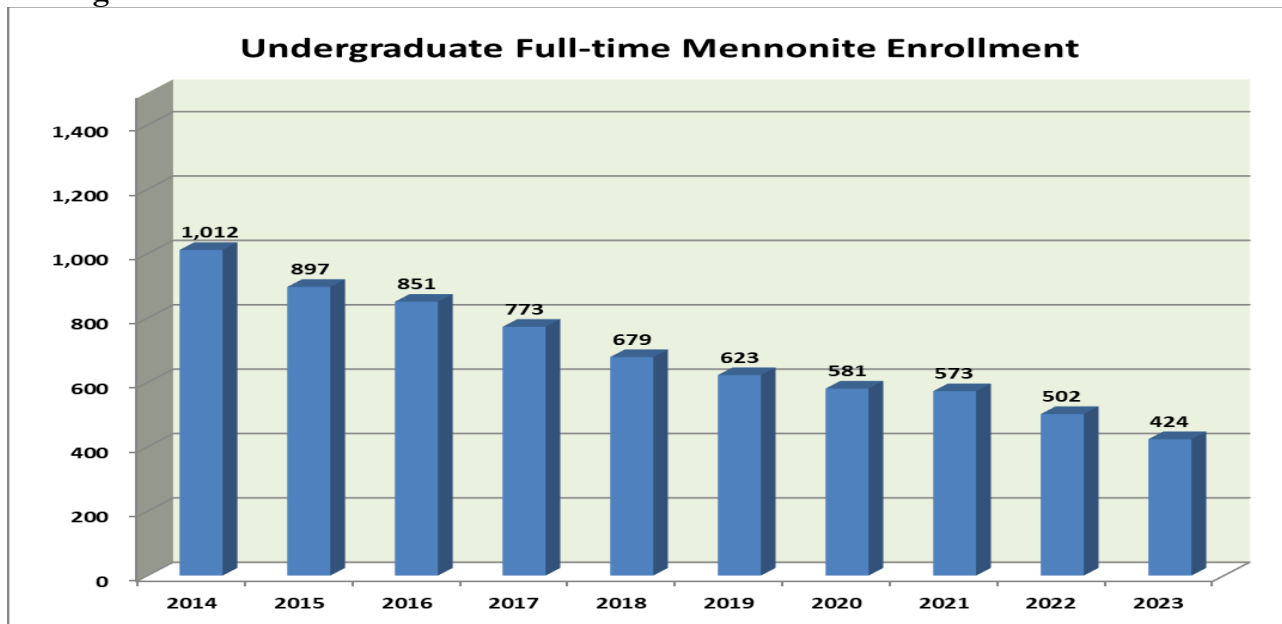

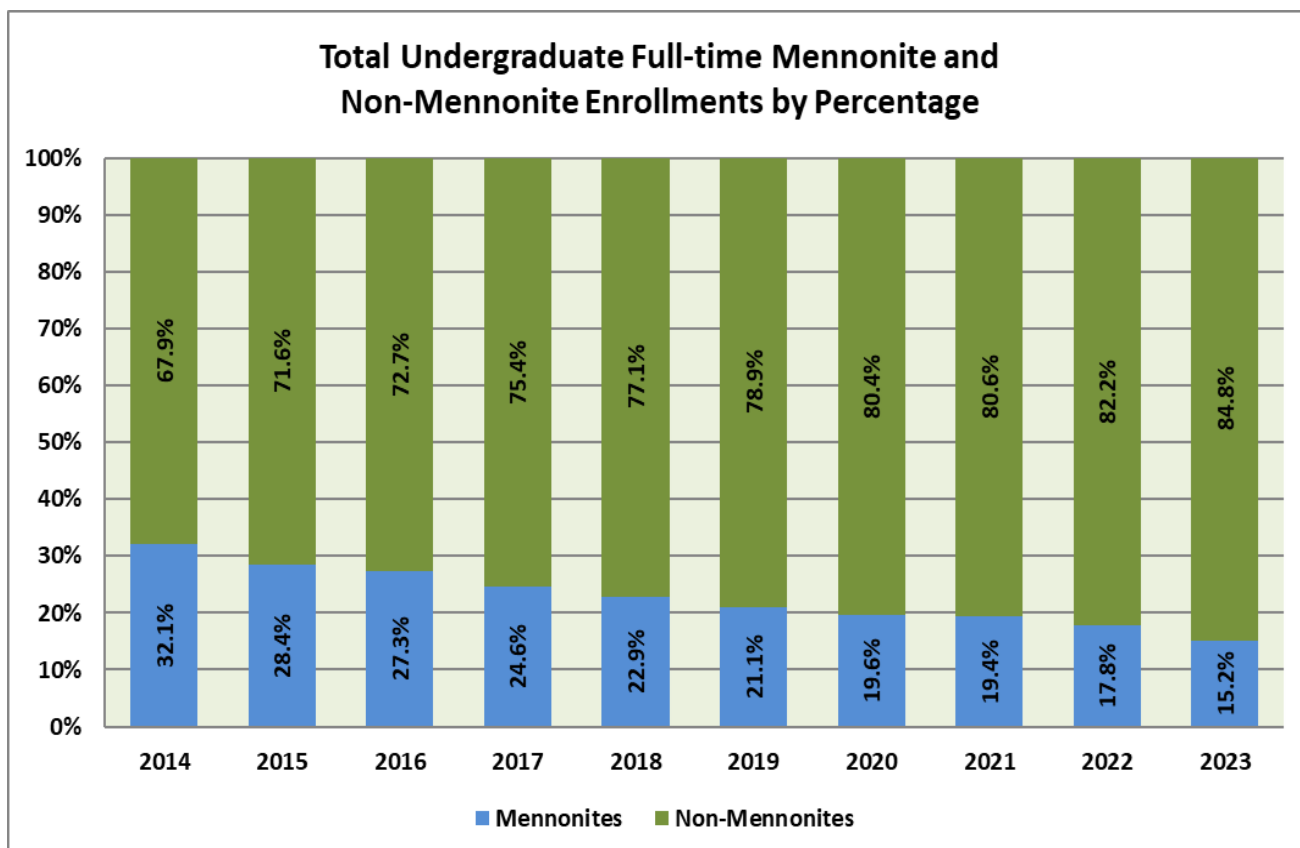
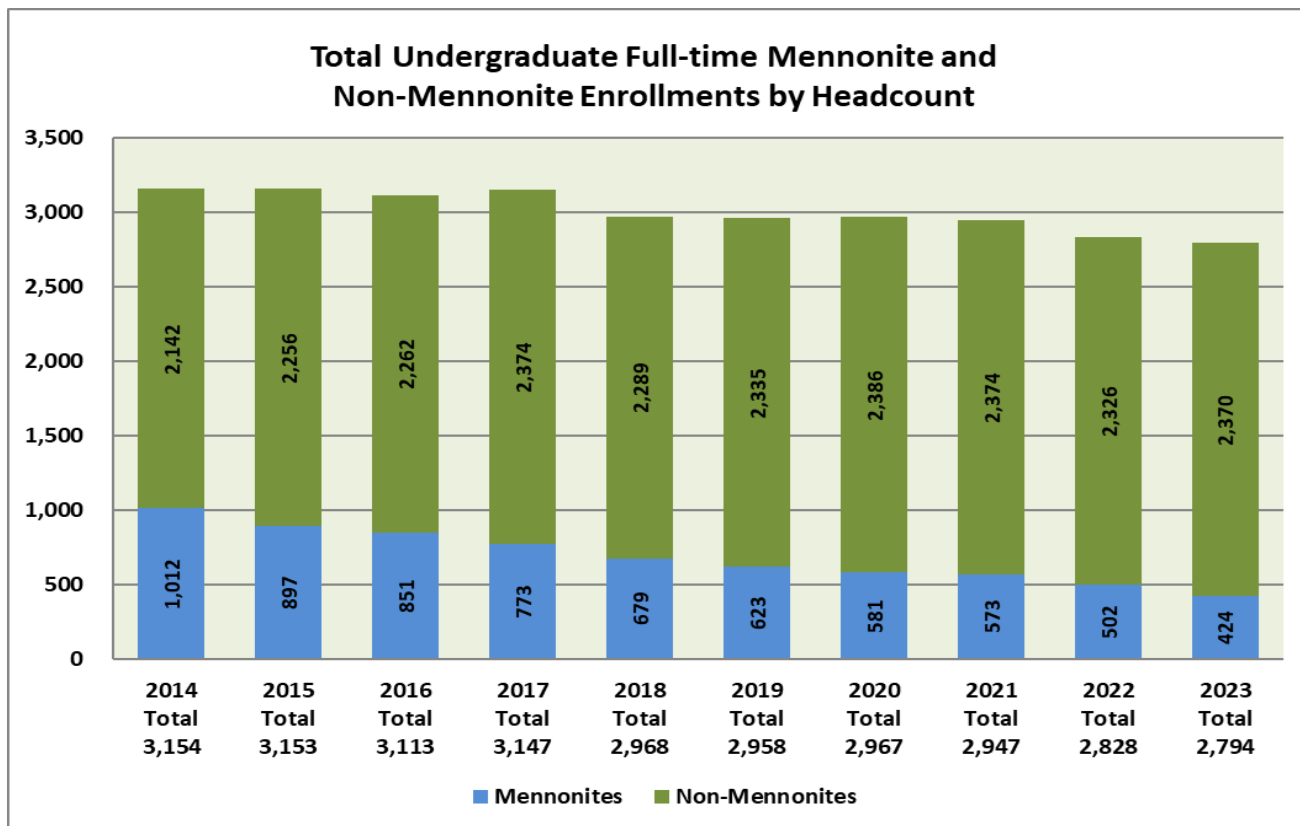
- The total BIPOC undergraduate student population increased 129 students (14.1%) from 916 (31.5% of total enrollment) in 2022 to 1,045 (35.9% of total enrollment) in 2023. Increases in undergraduate BIPOC enrollments were experienced at all five higher education institutions from fall 2022 to fall 2023: Bethel (6), Bluffton (41), EMU (30), Goshen (46), and Hesston (6).
- Of the total 1,045 BIPOC undergraduate population enrolled in fall 2023, 92 students (3.2%) were Mennonite, and 953 students (32.7%) were non-Mennonite. This compares to 2022 in which the total BIPOC undergraduate population was 916—69 students (2.4%) were Mennonite, and 847 students (29.1%) were non-Mennonite.
- The total number of Mennonite undergraduate BIPOC students in from 69 (2.4% of total enrollment) in 2022 to 92 (3.2% of total enrollment) in 2023. The total number of non-Mennonite BIPOC students increased by 106 students to 953 (32.7% of total enrollment) for that same period.

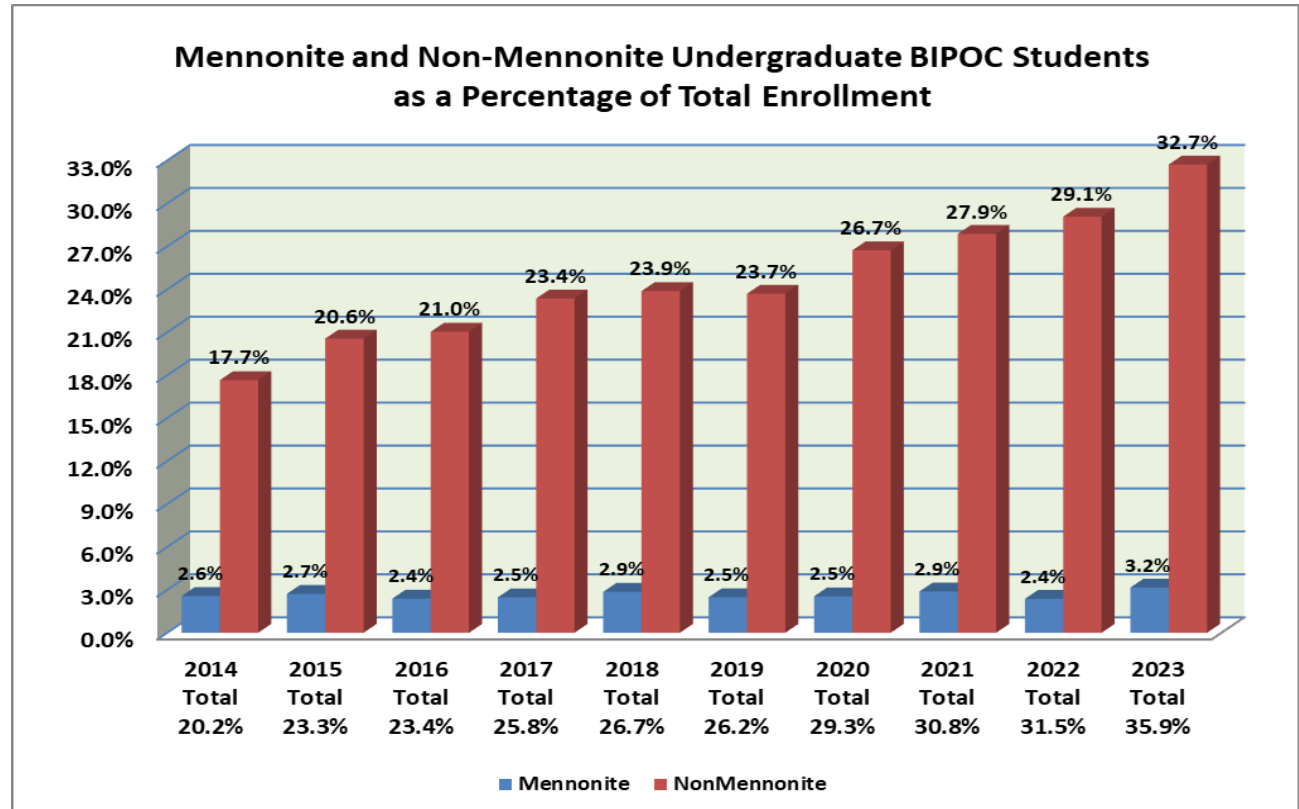
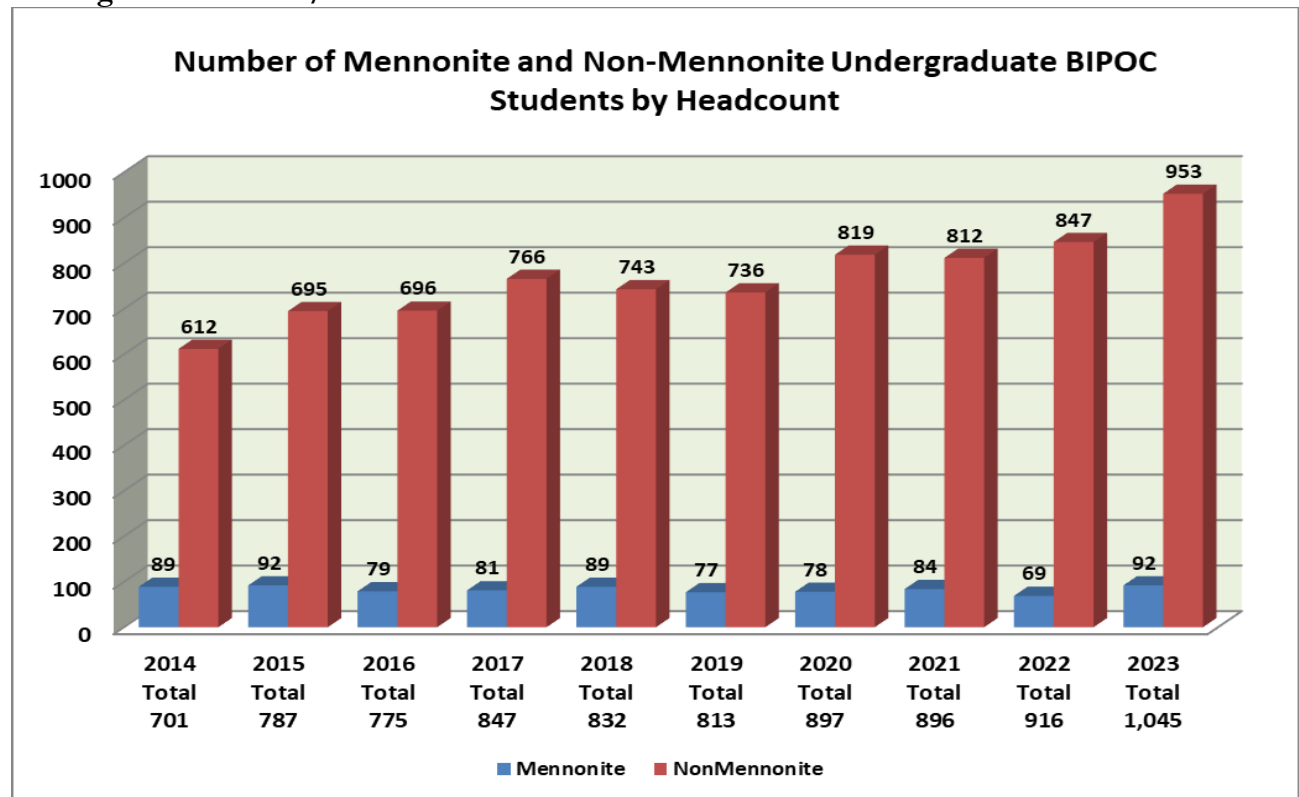


## Undergraduate Mennonite Enrollment Trends



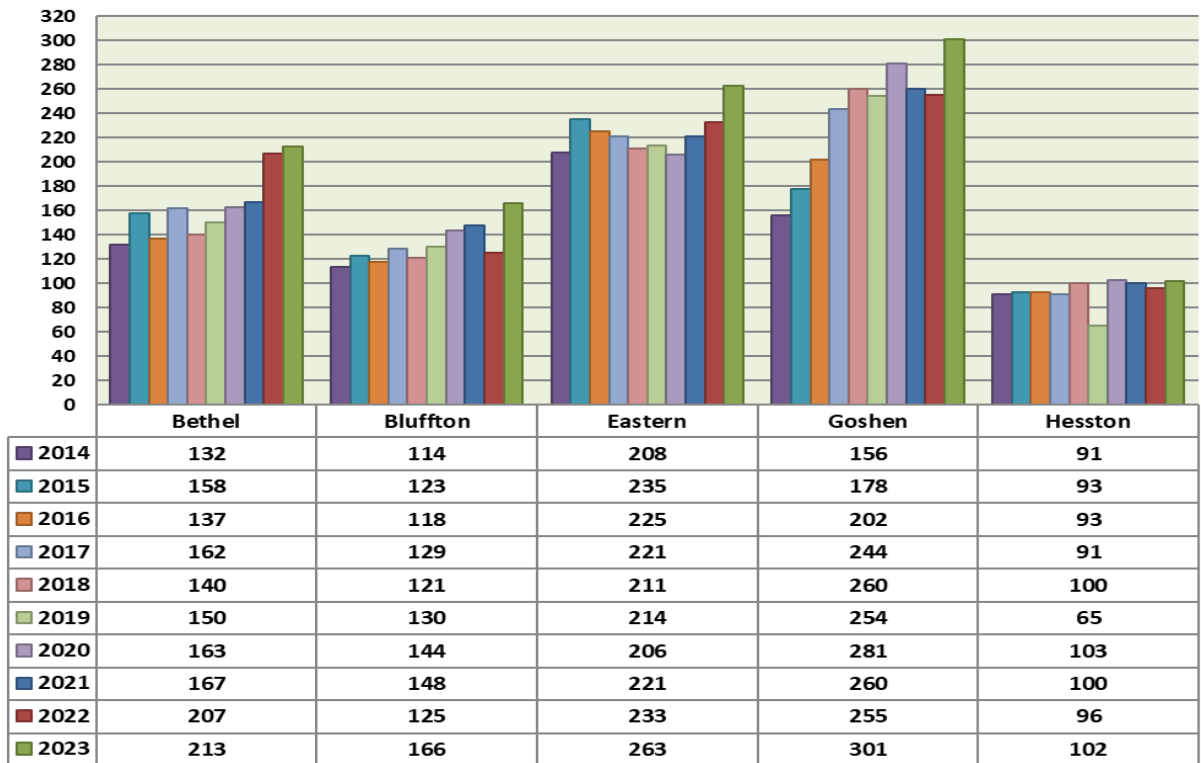


## Undergraduate Racial/Ethnic Enrollment Trends

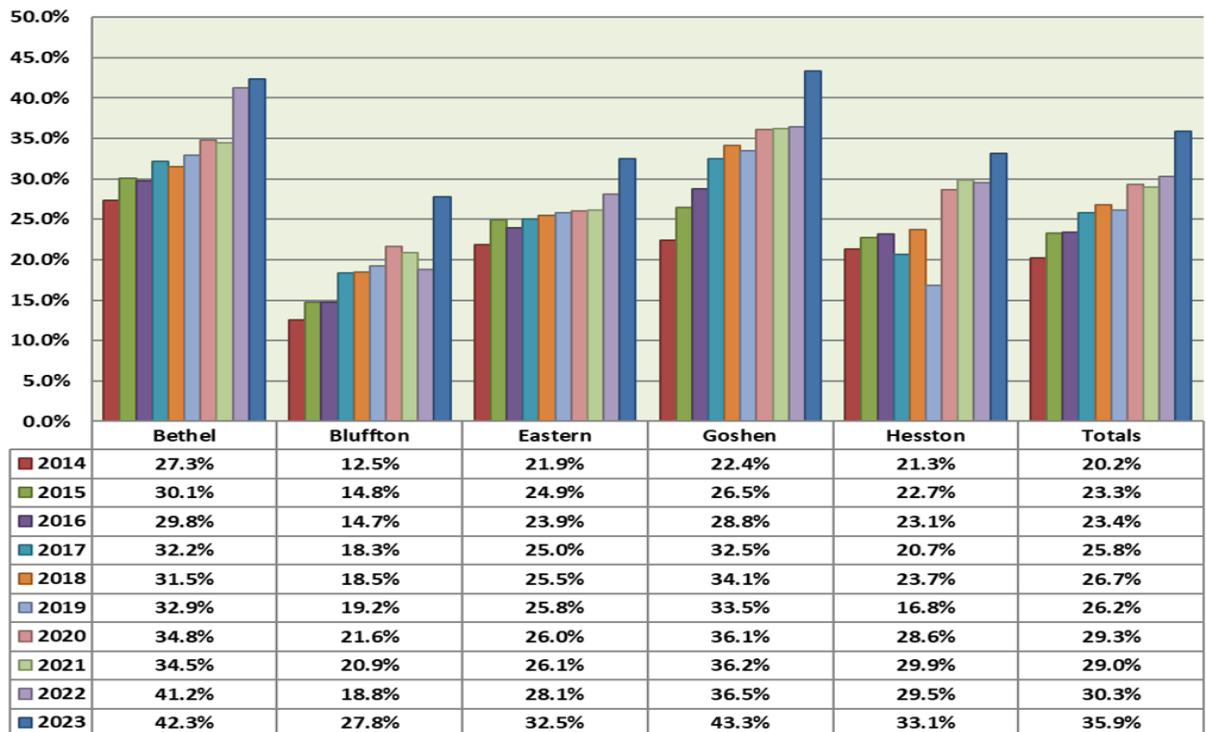




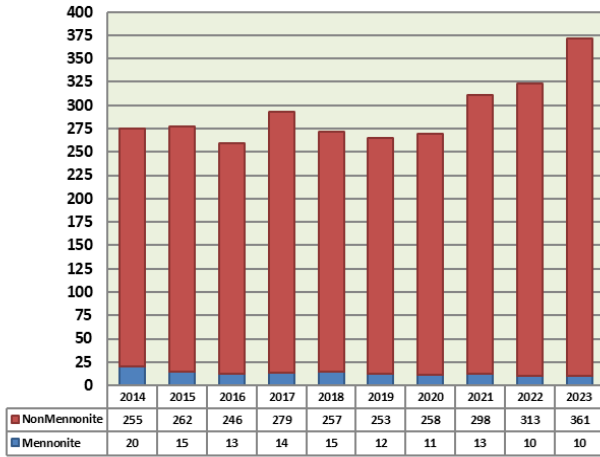
### Undergraduate BIPOC Enrollment by Institution



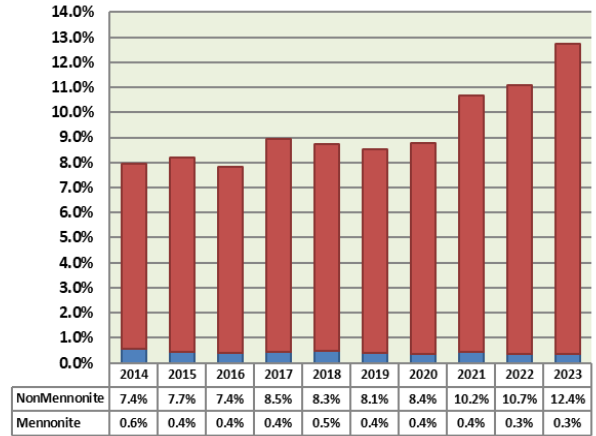
### Undergraduate BIPOC Students as a Percentage of Total Enrollment by Institution



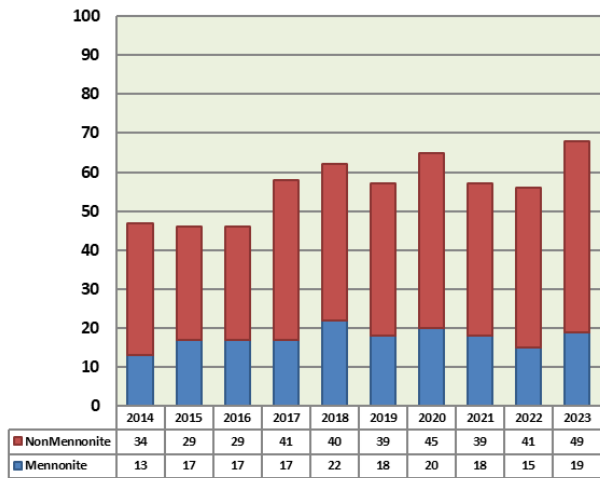
**Number of Mennonite and Non-Mennonite Undergraduate African American Students (US/CA)**



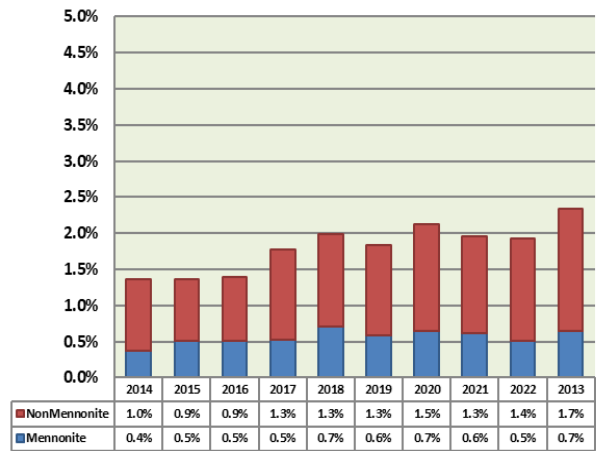
**Mennonite and Non-Mennonite Undergraduate African American Enrollments as a Percentage of Total Enrollment**



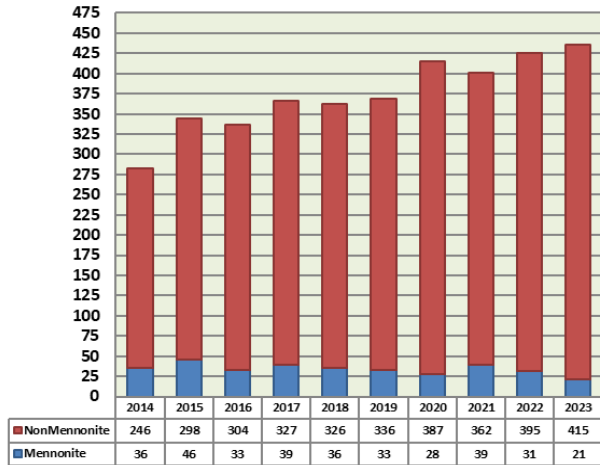
**Number of Mennonite and Non-Mennonite Undergraduate Asian/Pacific Islander Students (US/CA)**



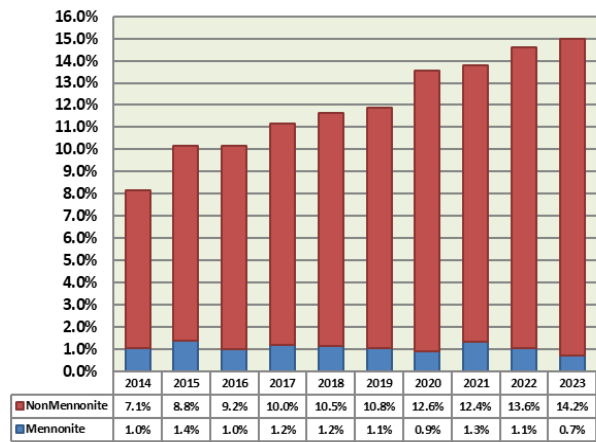
**Mennonite and Non-Mennonite Undergraduate Asian/Pacific Islander Enrollments as a Percentage of Total Enrollment**



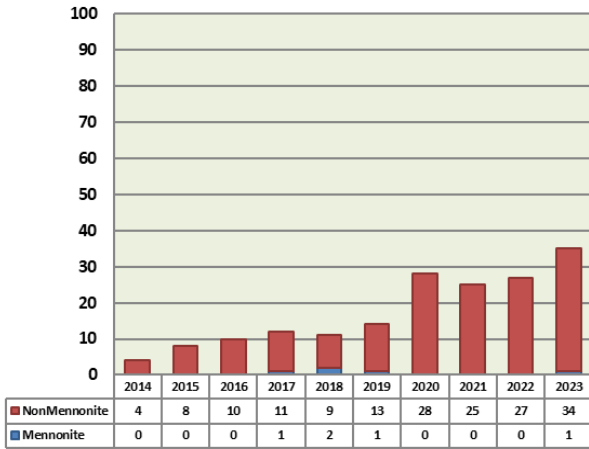
**Number of Mennonite and Non-Mennonite Undergraduate Hispanic Students (US/CA)**



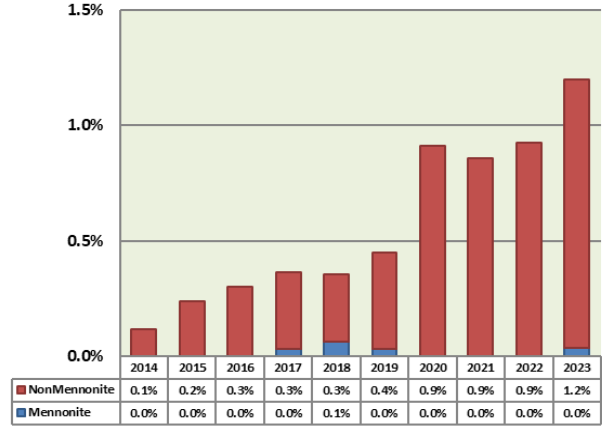
**Mennonite and Non-Mennonite Undergraduate Hispanic Enrollments as a Percentage of Total Enrollment**



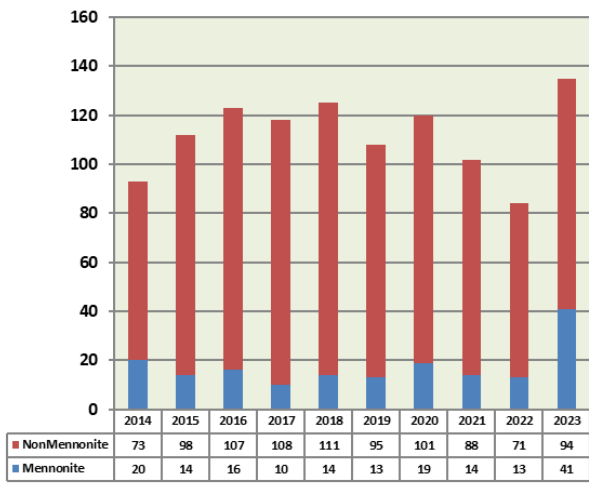
**Number of Mennonite and Non-Mennonite Undergraduate Native American Students (US/CA)**



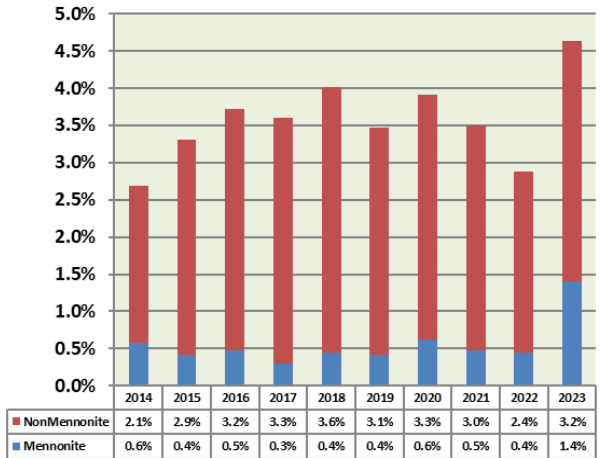
**Mennonite and Non-Mennonite Undergraduate Native American Enrollments as a Percentage of Total Enrollment**

**Mennonite and Non-Mennonite Undergraduate Other BIPOC Enrollments as a Percentage of Total Enrollment**



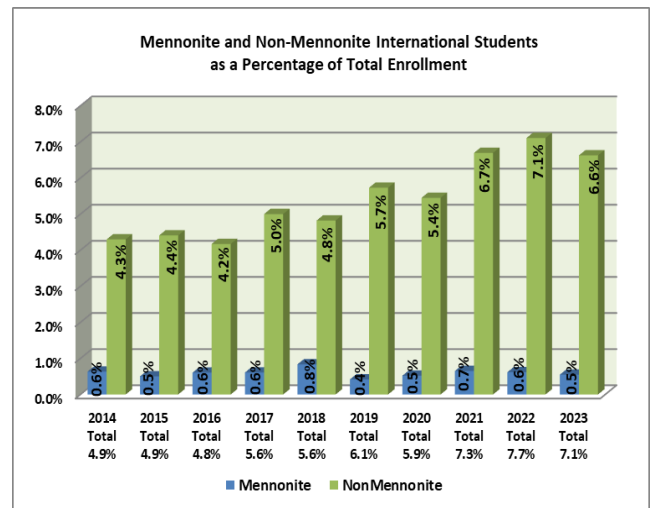
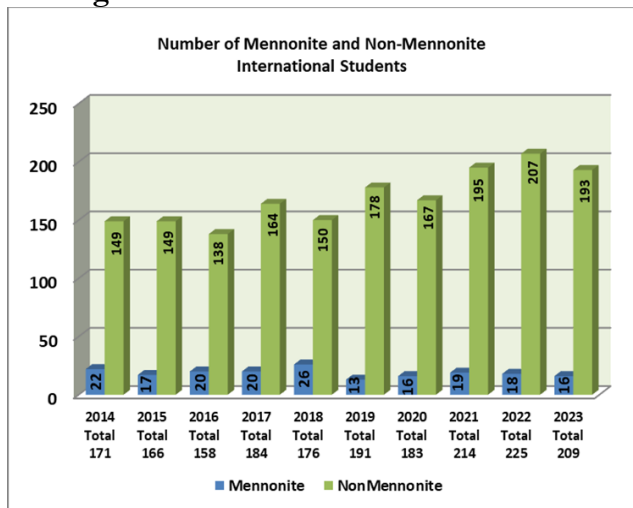
## **Undergrad Enrollment Changes**

- The 10-year total undergraduate BIPOC headcount increased 49.1%—from 701 (20.2%) students in fall 2014 to 1,045 (35.9%) students in fall 2023, an increase of 344 students.
- The 10-year total undergraduate African American headcount increased 34.9%—from 275 (8.0%) students in fall 2014 to 371 (12.7%) students in fall 2023, an increase of 96 students.
- The 10-year total undergraduate Asian/Pacific Islander headcount increased 44.7%—from 47 (1.4%) students in fall 2014 to 68 (2.4%) students in fall 2023, an increase of 21 students.
- The 10-year total undergraduate Hispanic headcount increased 54.6%—from 282 (8.1%) students in fall 2014 to 436 (14.9%) students in fall 2023, an increase of 154 students.
- The 10-year total undergraduate Native American headcount increased 775%—from 4 (0.1%) students in fall 2014 to 35 (1.2%) students in fall 2023, an increase of 31 students.
- The 10-year total undergraduate Other BIPOC headcount increased 45.2%—from 93 (2.7%) students in fall 2014 to 135 (4.6%) students in fall 2023, an increase of 42 students.

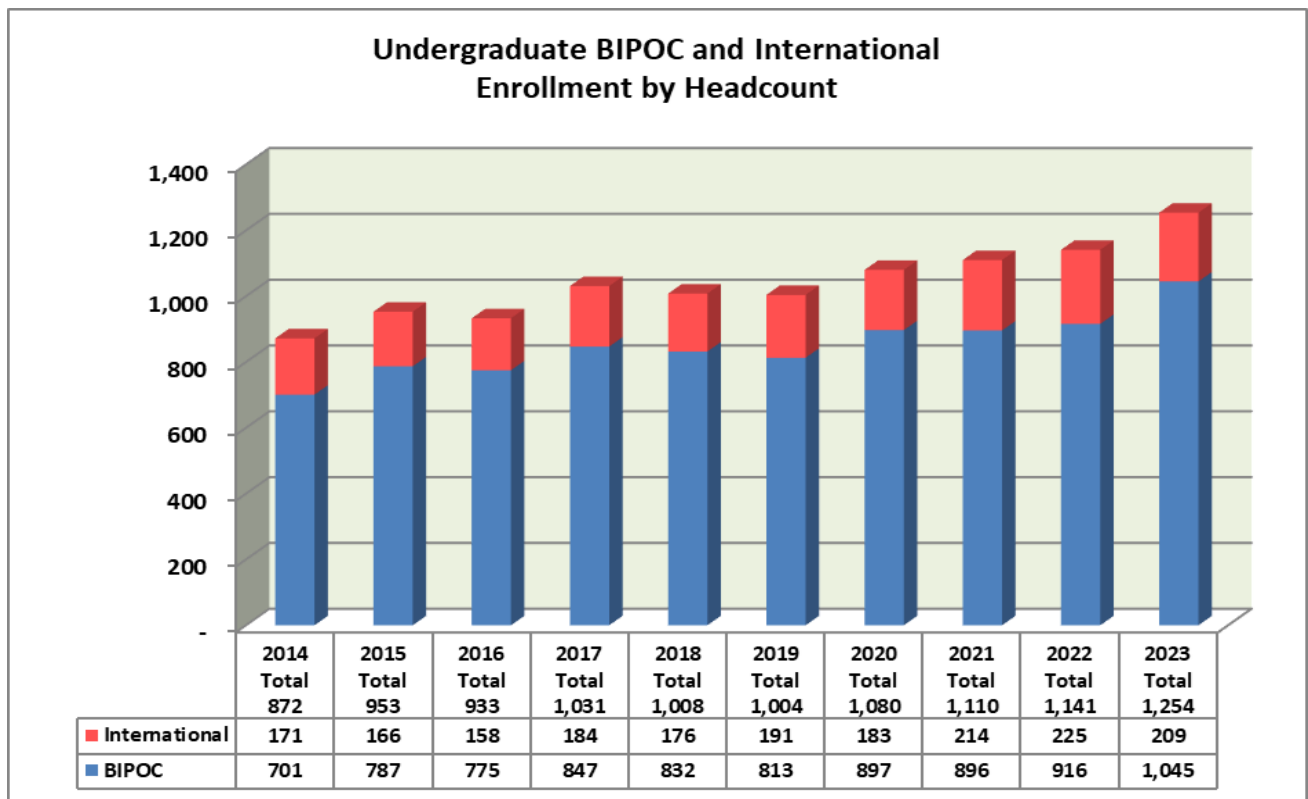
## **Mennonite BIPOC Enrollment Changes**

- In 2023, the total undergraduate Mennonite BIPOC student headcount increased 33.3% —from 69 (2.4%) in 2022 to 92 (3.2%) in 2023.
- The 10-year total undergraduate Mennonite BIPOC headcount increased 3.4%—from 89 (2.6%) students in fall 2014 to 92 (3.2%) students in fall 2023, an increase of 3 students.
- The 10-year total undergraduate Mennonite African American student headcount decreased 50.0%—from 20 (0.6%) students in fall 2014 to 10 (0.3%) students in fall 2023, a decrease of 10 students.
- The 10-year total undergraduate Mennonite Asian/Pacific Islander student headcount increased 46.2%—from 13 (0.4%) students in fall 2014 to 19 (0.7%) students in fall 2023, an increase of 6 students.
- The 10-year total undergraduate Mennonite Hispanic student headcount decreased 41.7%—from 36 (1.0%) students in fall 2014 to 21 (0.7%) students in fall 2023, a decrease of 15 students.
- The 10-year total undergraduate Mennonite Native American student headcount increased—from 0 (0.0%) students in fall 2014 to 1 (0.0%) students in fall 2023. It continues to be a challenge to attract Native American students to our campuses.
- The 10-year total undergraduate Mennonite Other BIPOC student headcount increased 105%—from 20 (0.6%) students in fall 2014 to 41 (1.4%) students in fall 2023, an increase of 21 students.

## Undergraduate International Students



In 2023, international students (209) made up 7.1% of undergraduate enrollment. Sixteen students (0.5% of the total headcount population) were Mennonite, and 193 students (6.6% of the total headcount population) were non-Mennonite.

- The adult degree-completion enrollment increased by 43 students (46.2%), from 93 students in fall 2022 to 136 students in fall 2023.

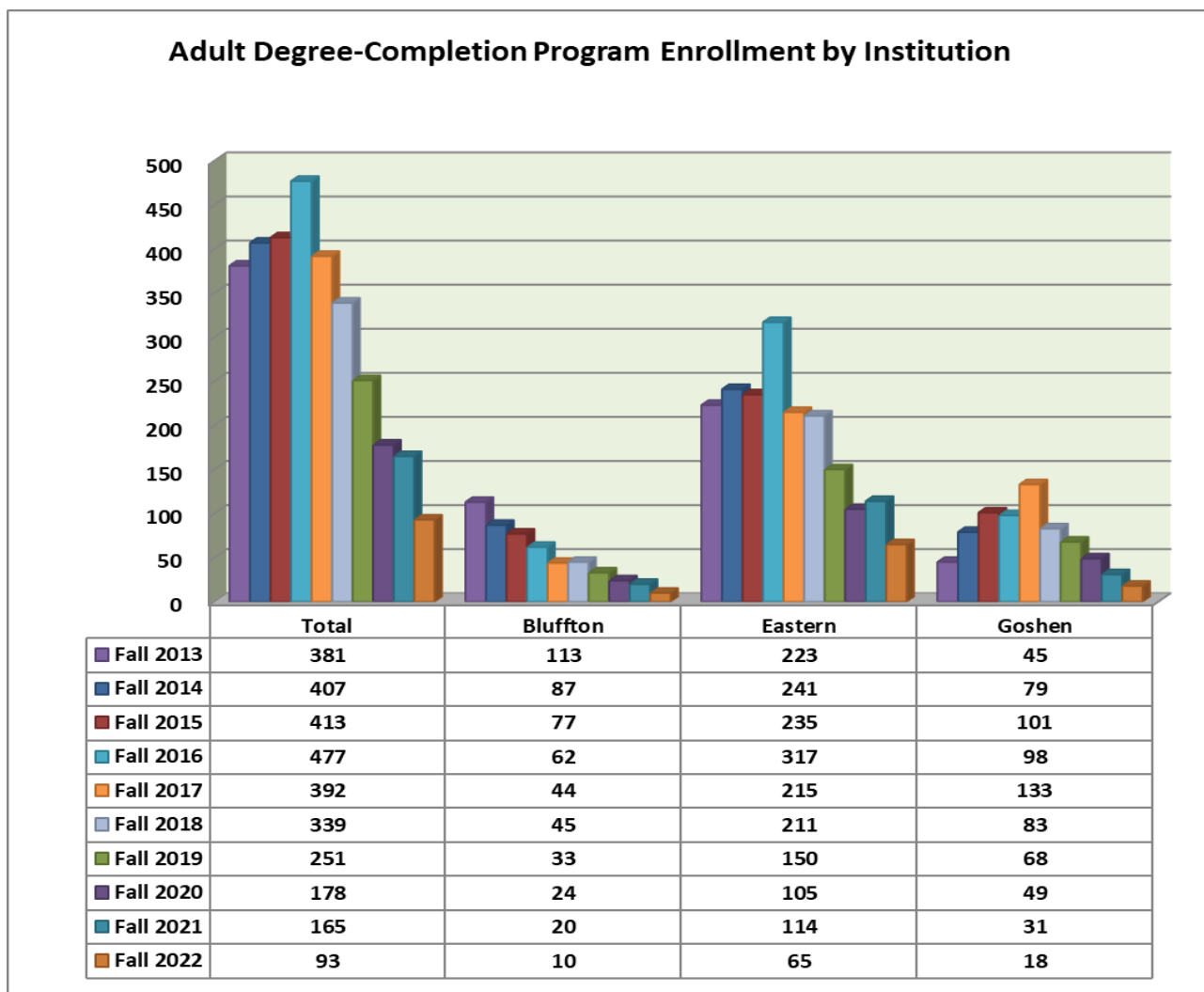
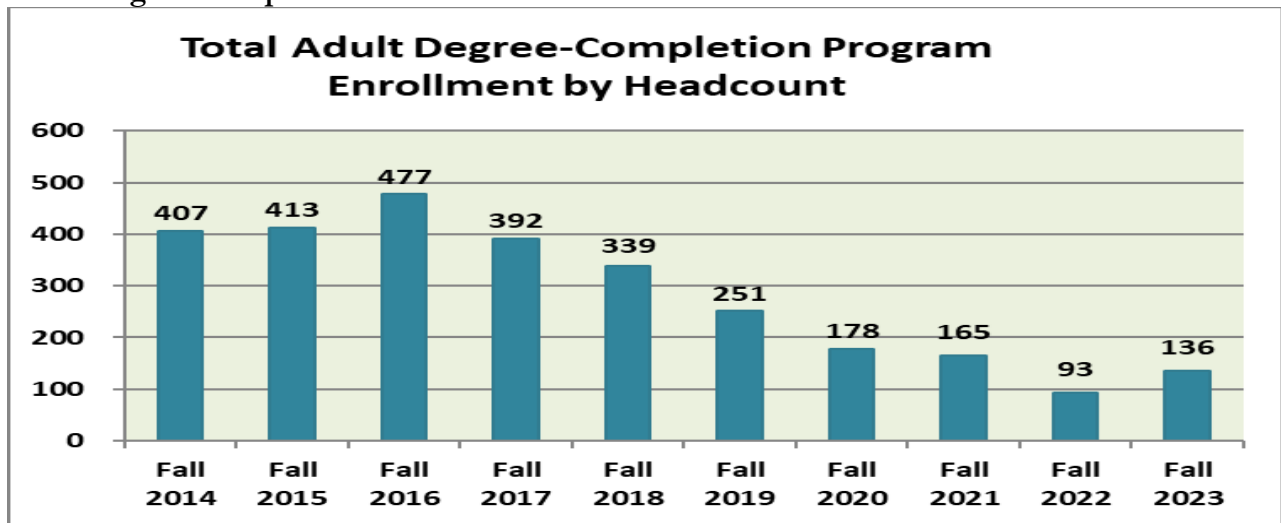
### **Current Year Mennonite Church Enrollment**

- Mennonite student participation in adult degree-completion programs decreased by 1 student, from 9 students in 2022 to 8 students in 2023. In 2023, Mennonite students comprised 5.9% of the total adult degree-completion program headcount, and in 2022, 9.7%.

### **Current Year Adult Degree-Completion BIPOC Enrollment**

- Bluffton, EMU and Goshen offer adult degree-completion programs, and 19.1% (26 students) of the combined enrollment in fall 2023 were students from BIPOC origin based on headcount. In fall 2022 BIPOC students accounted for 16.1% (15 students) of total enrollment.

## **HIGHER EDUCATION: Graduate Programs (Not seminary)**

### **Current Year**

- Bluffton, EMU and Goshen offer graduate level programs. The combined graduate enrollment headcount decreased 2.3% from 530 students in fall 2022 to 518 students in fall 2023. Enrollments may fluctuate significantly from year to year due to the nature and timing of courses and programs offered for professional development. In fall 2023 two institutions reported a decrease in graduate program enrollments: Bluffton decreased 6.2% (5 students) from 81 in 2022 to 76 students in 2023. EMU decreased 1.8% (7 students) from 398 in 2022 to 391 students in 2023. Goshen had 51 students for both 2022 and 2023.

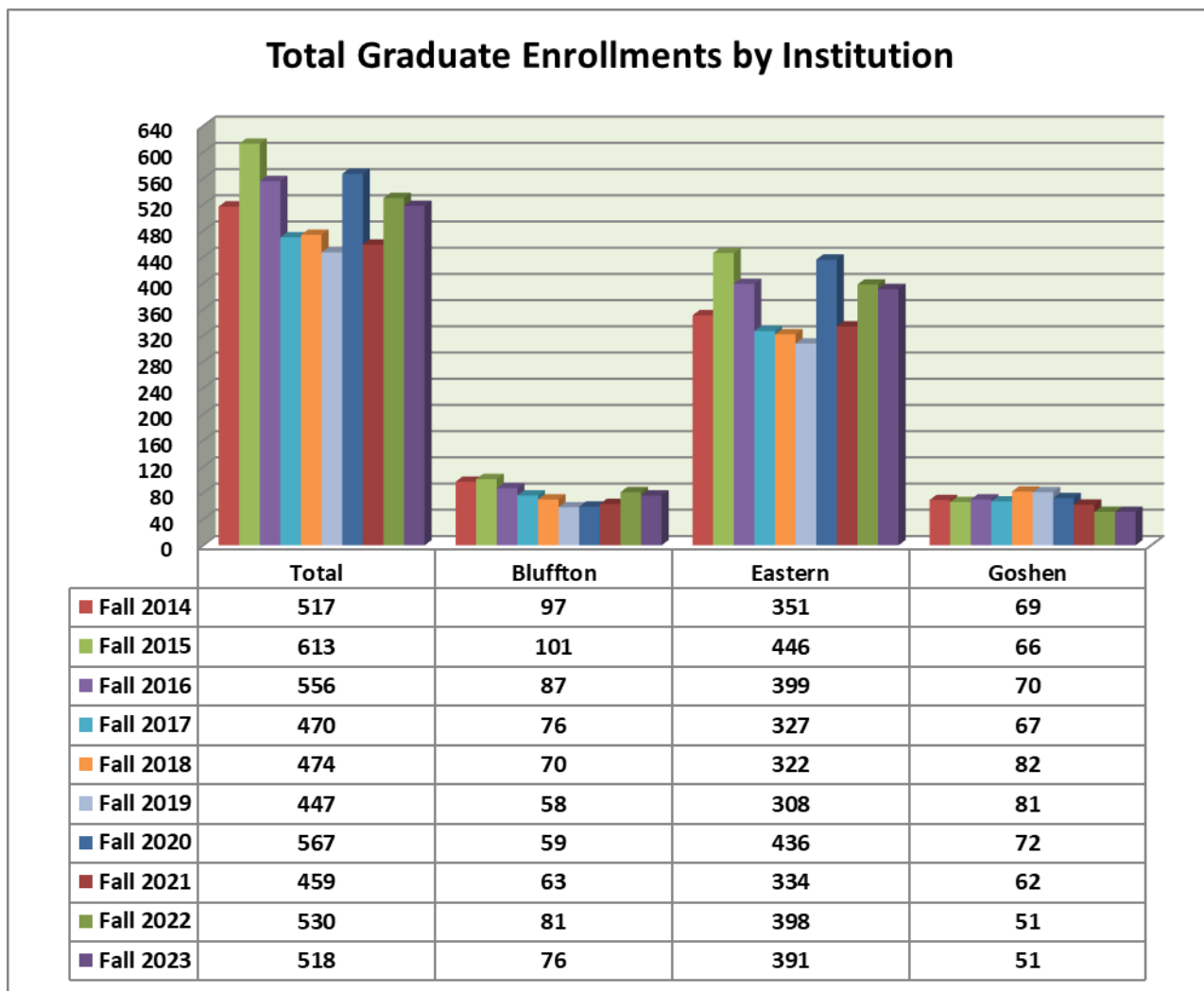
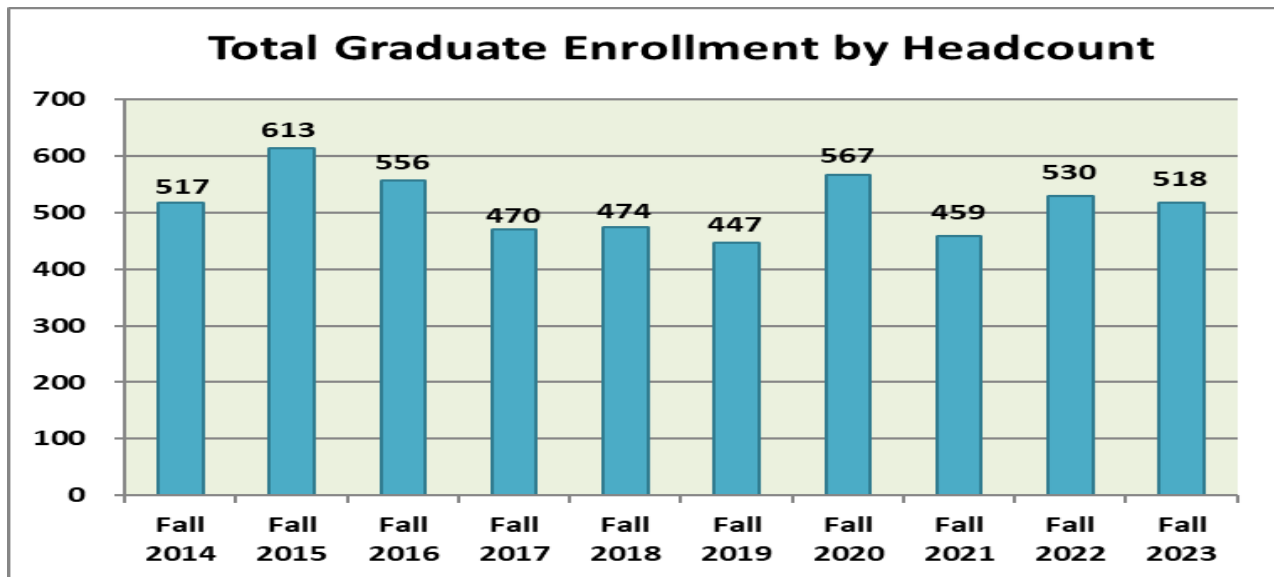
### **Current Year Mennonite Enrollment**

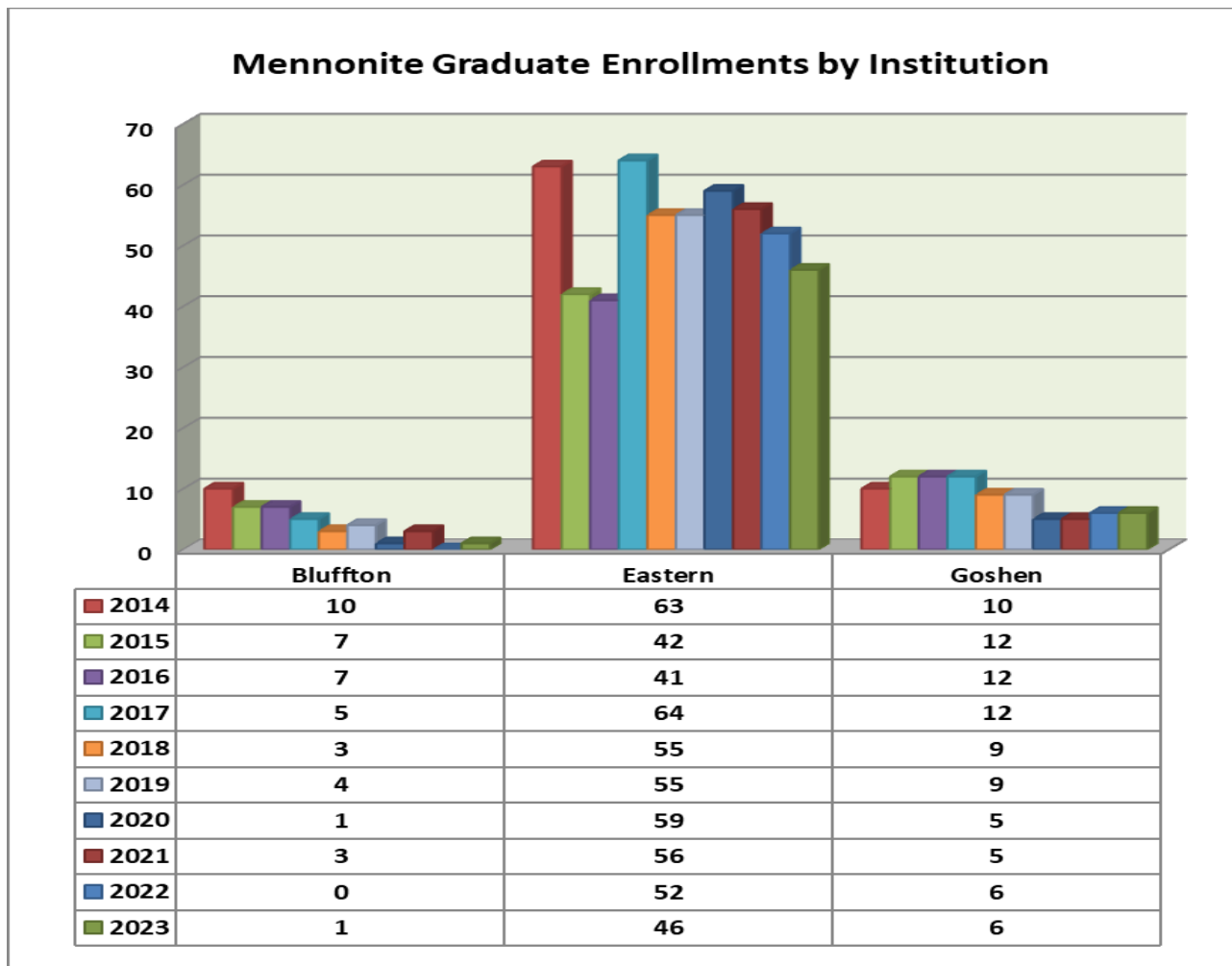
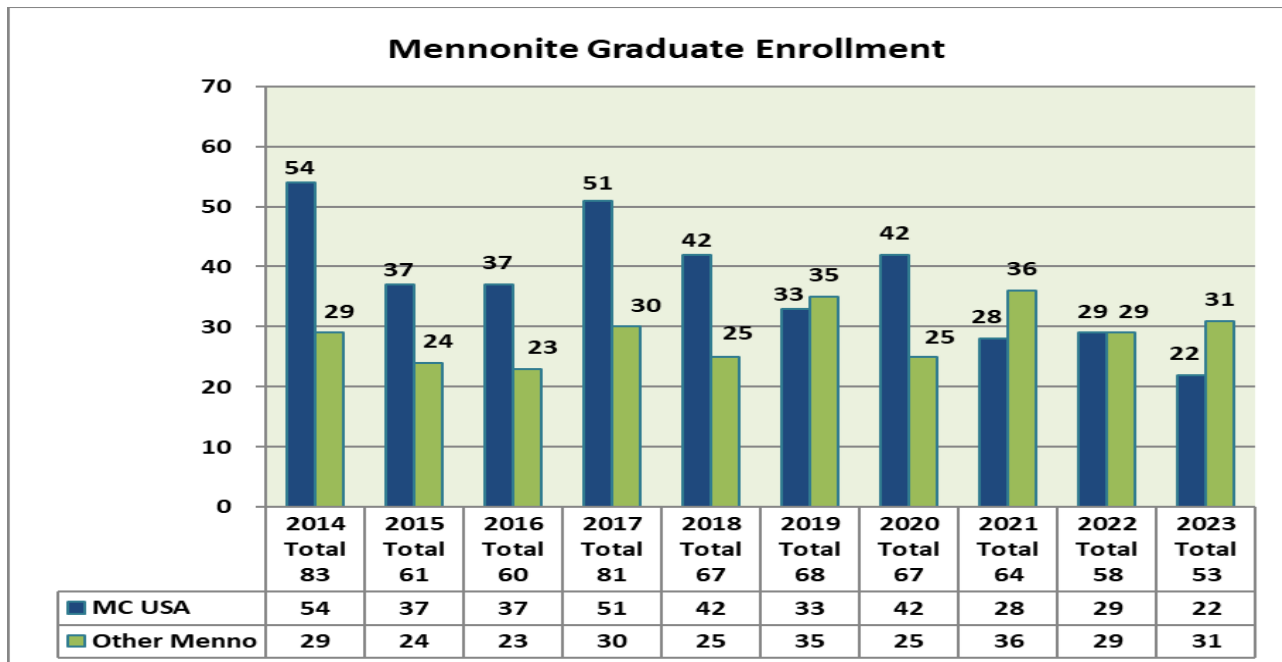
### **Current Year Graduate BIPOC Enrollment**

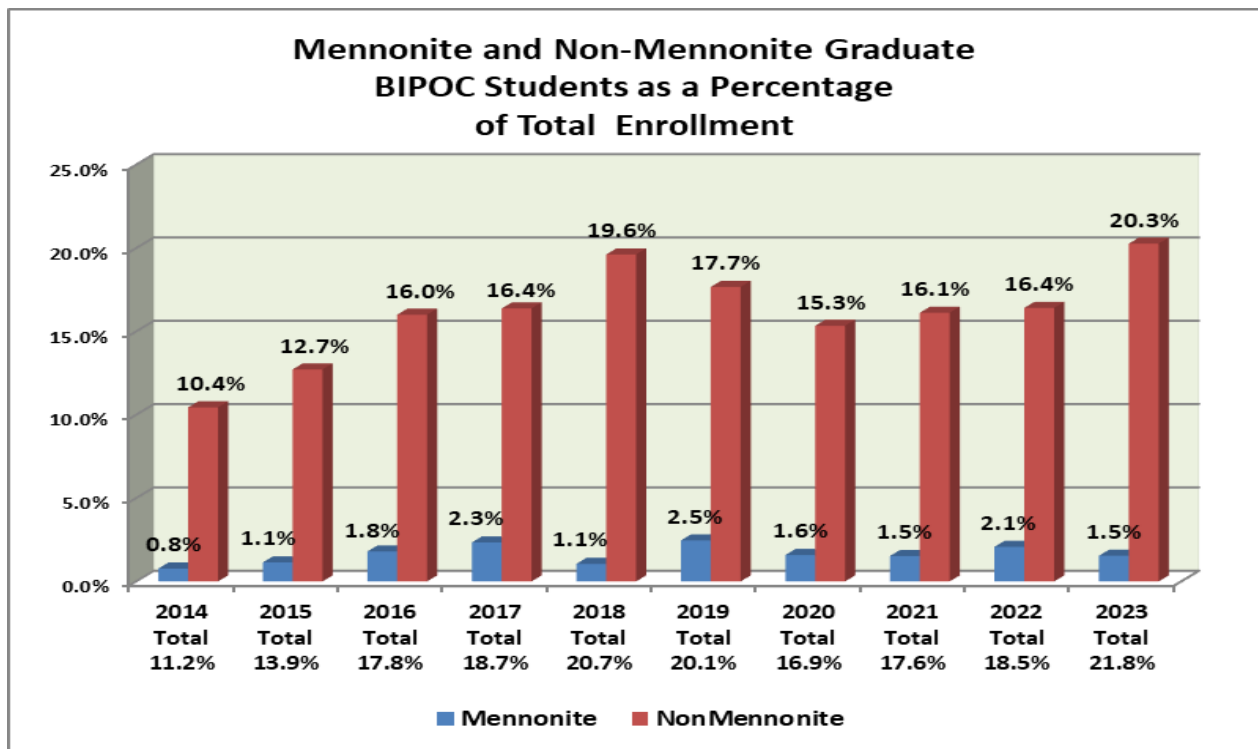
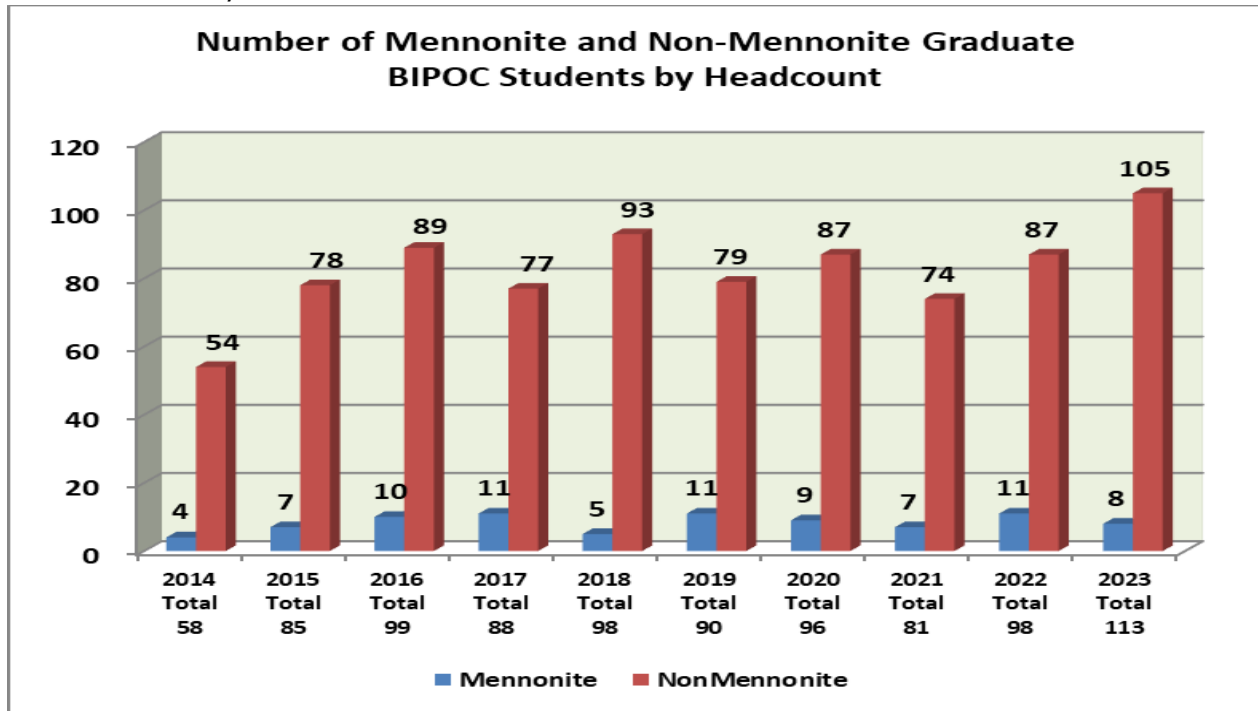
## Graduate Education Trends

## HIGHER EDUCATION: Seminary

### Current Year

- The seminary enrollment headcount for Anabaptist Mennonite Biblical Seminary (AMBS) and Eastern Mennonite Seminary (EMS) increased 1.1%, from 185 in fall 2022 to 187 in fall 2023, An increase of 2 students – AMBS increased by 8 (5.7%) and EMS decreased by 6 (13.6%).
- The seminary full-time enrollment increased 5.1% from 39 in fall 2022 to 41 in fall 2023, an increase of 2 students – AMBS increased by 7 (29.2%) and EMS decreased by 5 (33.3%).
- The seminary part-time enrollment stayed the same, from 146 in fall 2022 to 146 in fall 2023 – AMBS increased by 1 (0.9%) and EMS decreased by 1 (3.4%).
- The seminary full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment increased 6.5%, from 77 FTE in fall 2022 to 82 FTE in fall 2023, an increase of 5 FTE – AMBS increased by 11 (21.2%) and EMS decreased by 6 (24.0%).

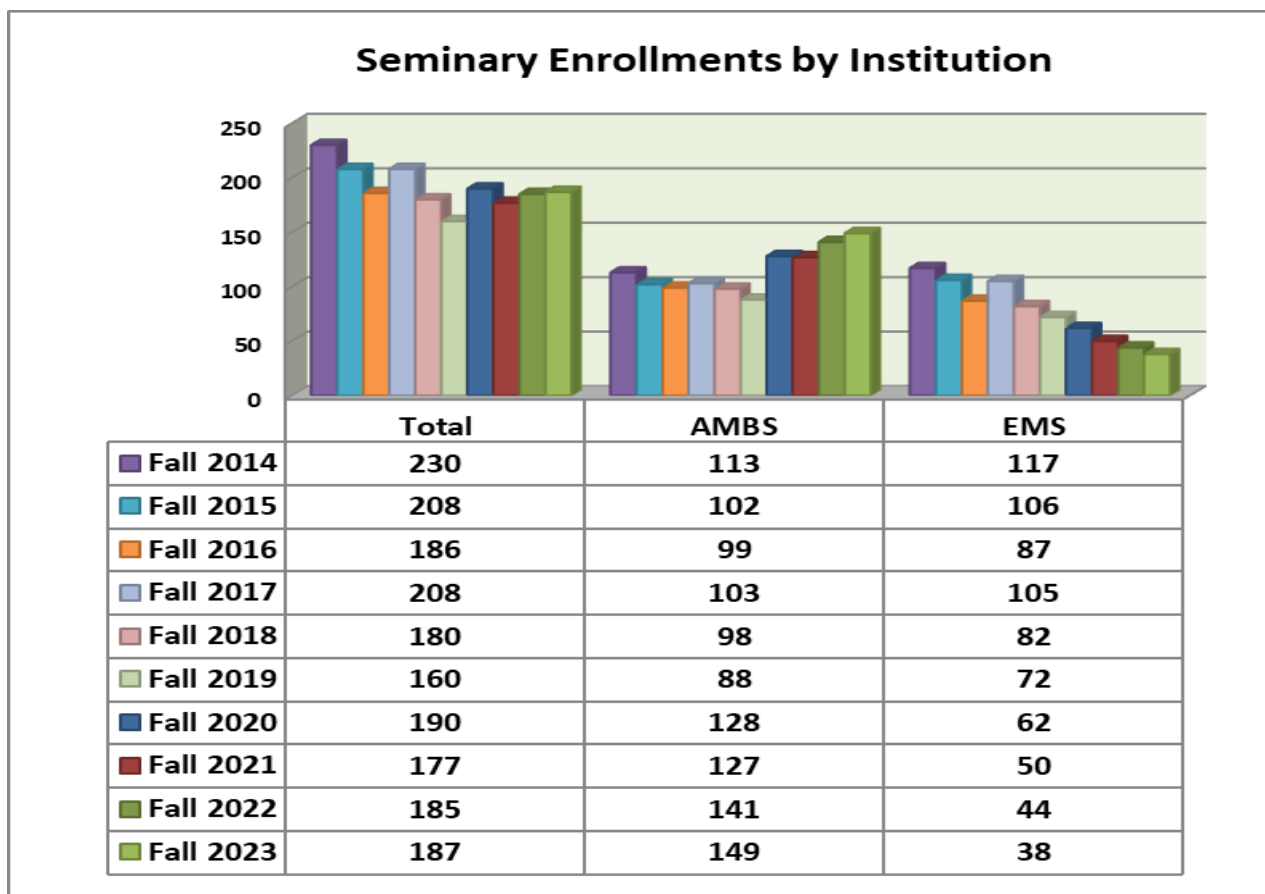
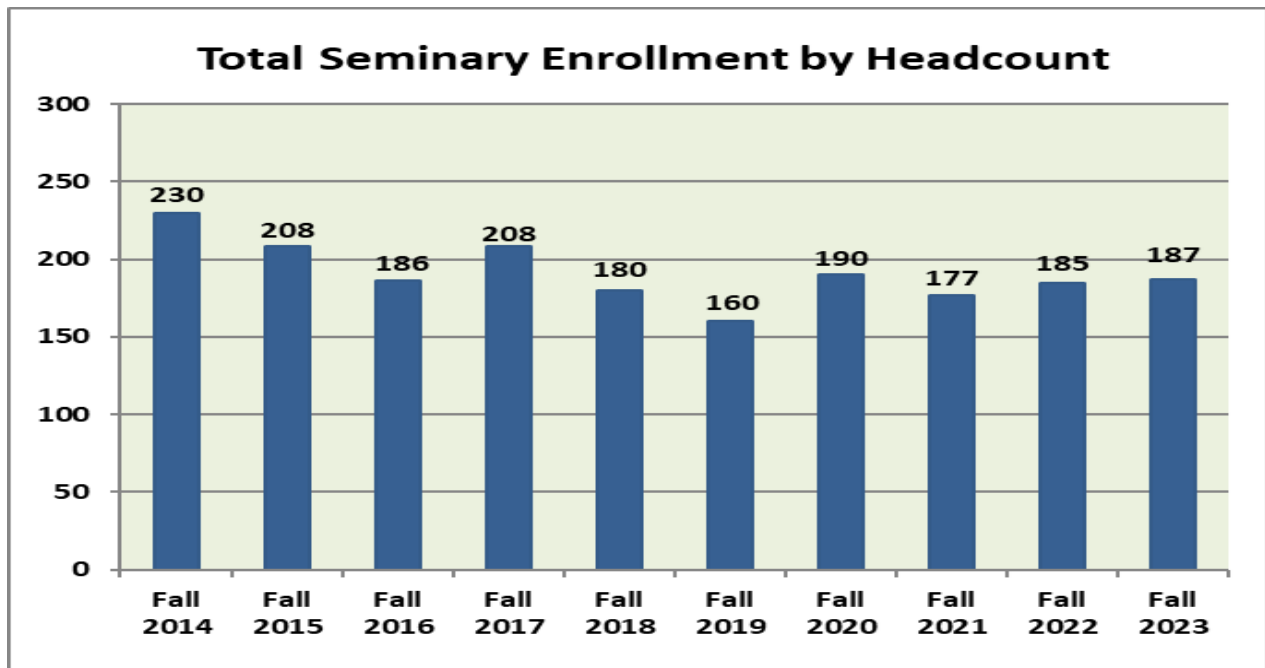
The reporting format coordinates the data collection from the seminaries with reports already completed for Association of Theological Schools (ATS). This format does not separate part-time Mennonite Church USA students from other Mennonite students which impacts certain church headcount reports.

- When all Mennonites enrolled at the seminaries are accounted for, 132 full-time and part-time students made up 70.6% of the total enrollment headcount in 2023, as compared with 131 Mennonite students for 70.8% of the total headcount in 2022. The number of full-time Mennonite students attending seminary in 2023 was 31 (16.6% of the total enrollment headcount), compared to 28 (15.1%) in 2022.

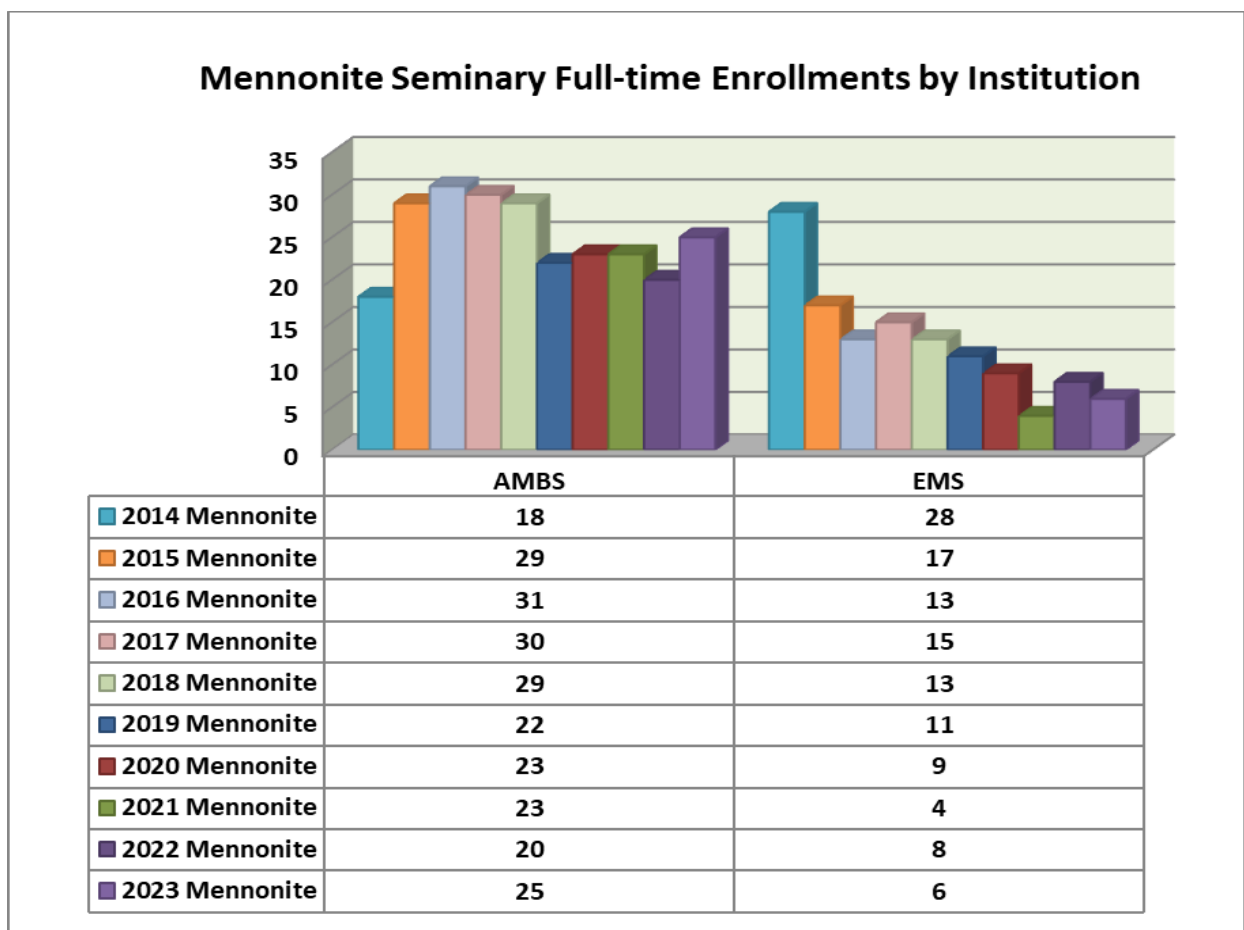
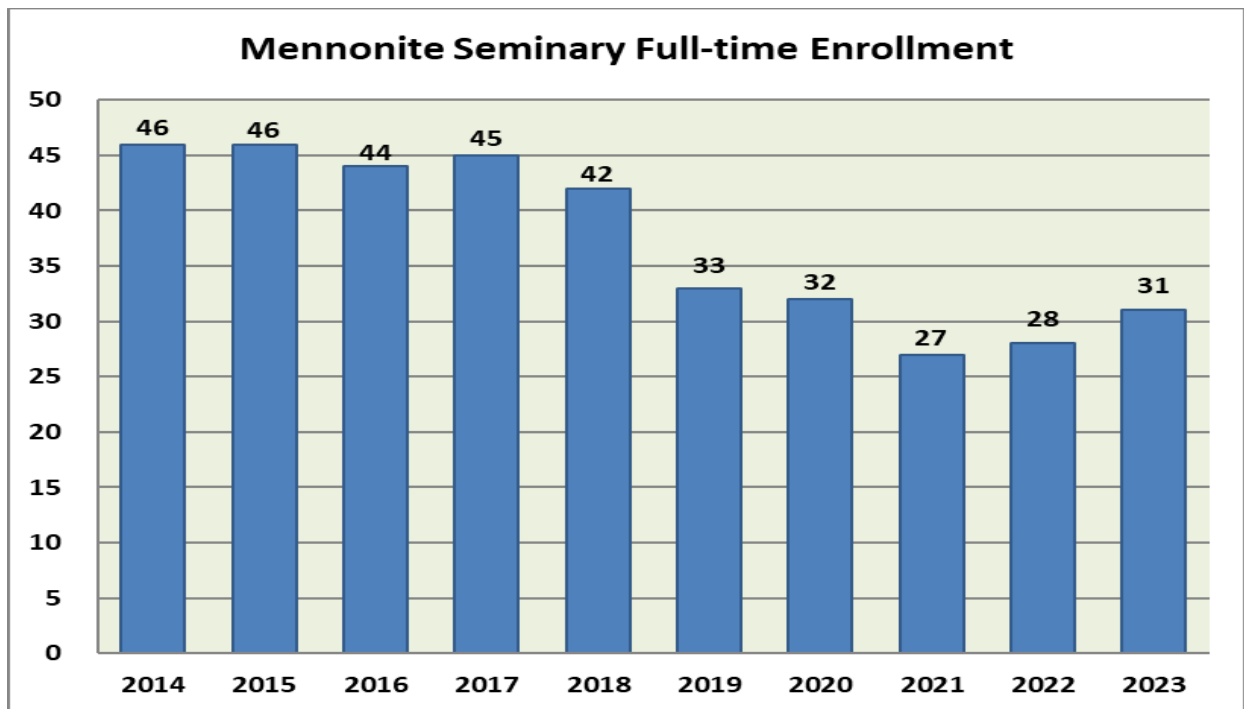
### Current Year Seminary BIPOC Enrollment

- BIPOC students made up 10.2% (19 students) and international students 40.1% (75 students) for a combined 50.3% (94 students) of the total seminary enrollment based on headcount for fall 2023. BIPOC students accounted for 9.7% (18 students) and international students 42.2% (78 students) for a combined 51.9% (96 students) of total seminary enrollment in fall 2022.

## Seminary Mennonite Education Trends



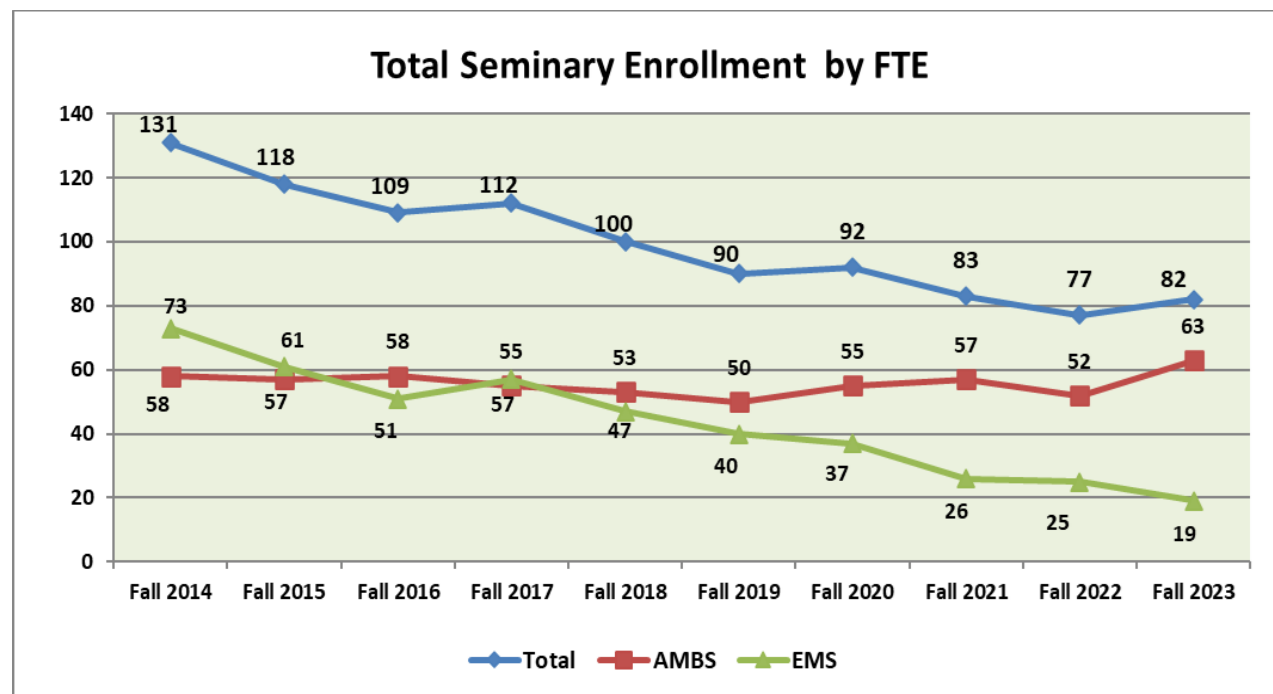

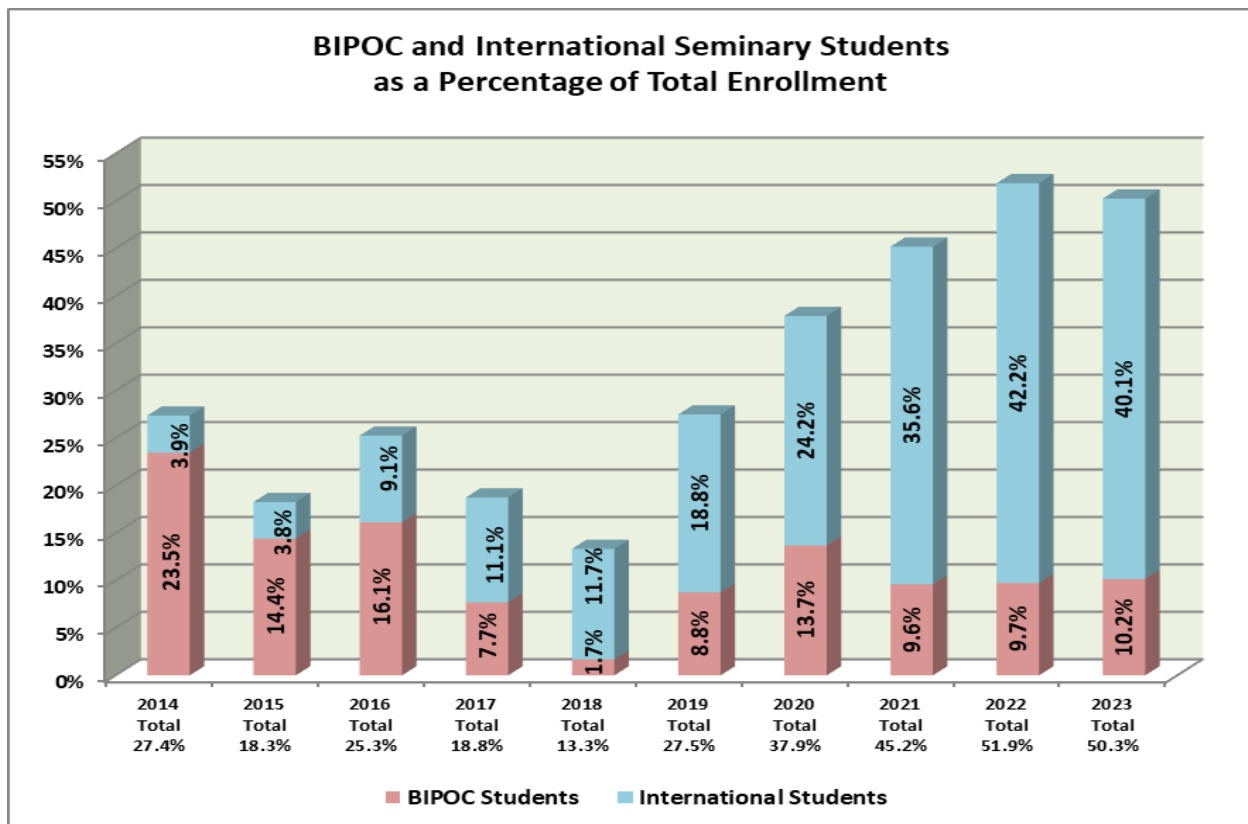
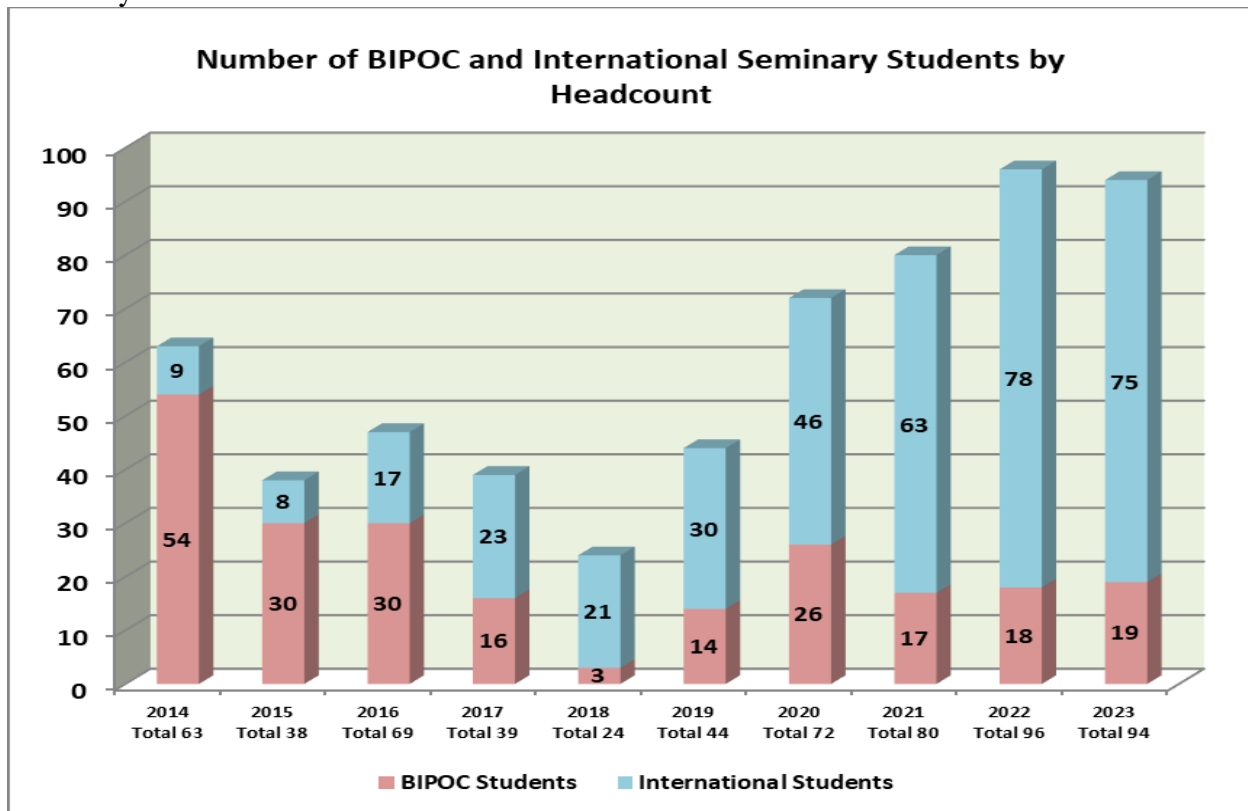

The mission of Instituto Bíblico Anabautista (IBA) is to provide educational resources that promote biblical theological training of Spanish-speaking leaders who will serve Mennonite Church USA in various ministries. IBA functions under Mennonite Education Agency (MEA) in partnership with Mennonite Mission Network and Iglesia Menonita Hispana. IBA is a biblical and theological education program for ministerial preparation. It was founded in 1988 to fulfill the vision of the Reference Council of the Hispanic Ministries Department of the former General Conference Mennonite Church.

The institute functions by study centers in the local congregations with a tutor assigned to each center. Most of the students take an active part in the leadership of their congregations, such as serving as Sunday school teachers or deacons, while others have been chosen as pastors and/or church planters.

**For the year 2022-2023, IBA had:**

- A total of 102 students in 17 centers
- 17 centers in 8 states
- An average of 6 students per center
- A total of 20 volunteer tutors and coordinators
- 12 different courses taught, and one workshop
